19 **Comparison With Attack Periods**

Capture	Date	Duration	RST Count	RST Rate
EVID-0012 (Attack Resume)	Oct 31	3.25 min	131	40.3/min
EVID-0013 (This)	Oct 30	12.7 min	3	0.24/min
EVID-0006 (Router Attack)	Oct 18	~10 min	9,516	951.6/min

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Significance

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This capture was taken AFTER the plaintiff called Xfinity/Comcast.

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The dramatic reduction in RST activity (from ~40/min to 0.24/min)

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demonstrates that the attack PAUSED during/after ISP contact.

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The attack RESUMED the following day (EVID-0012).

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
