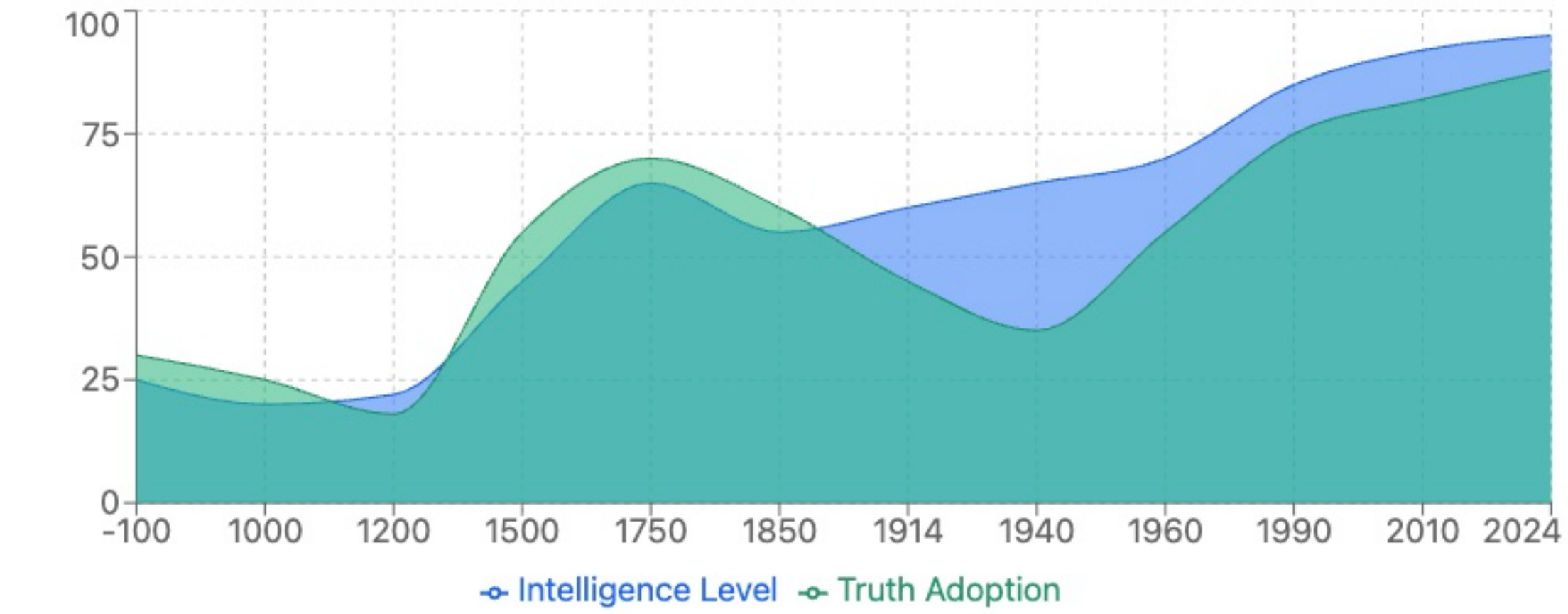

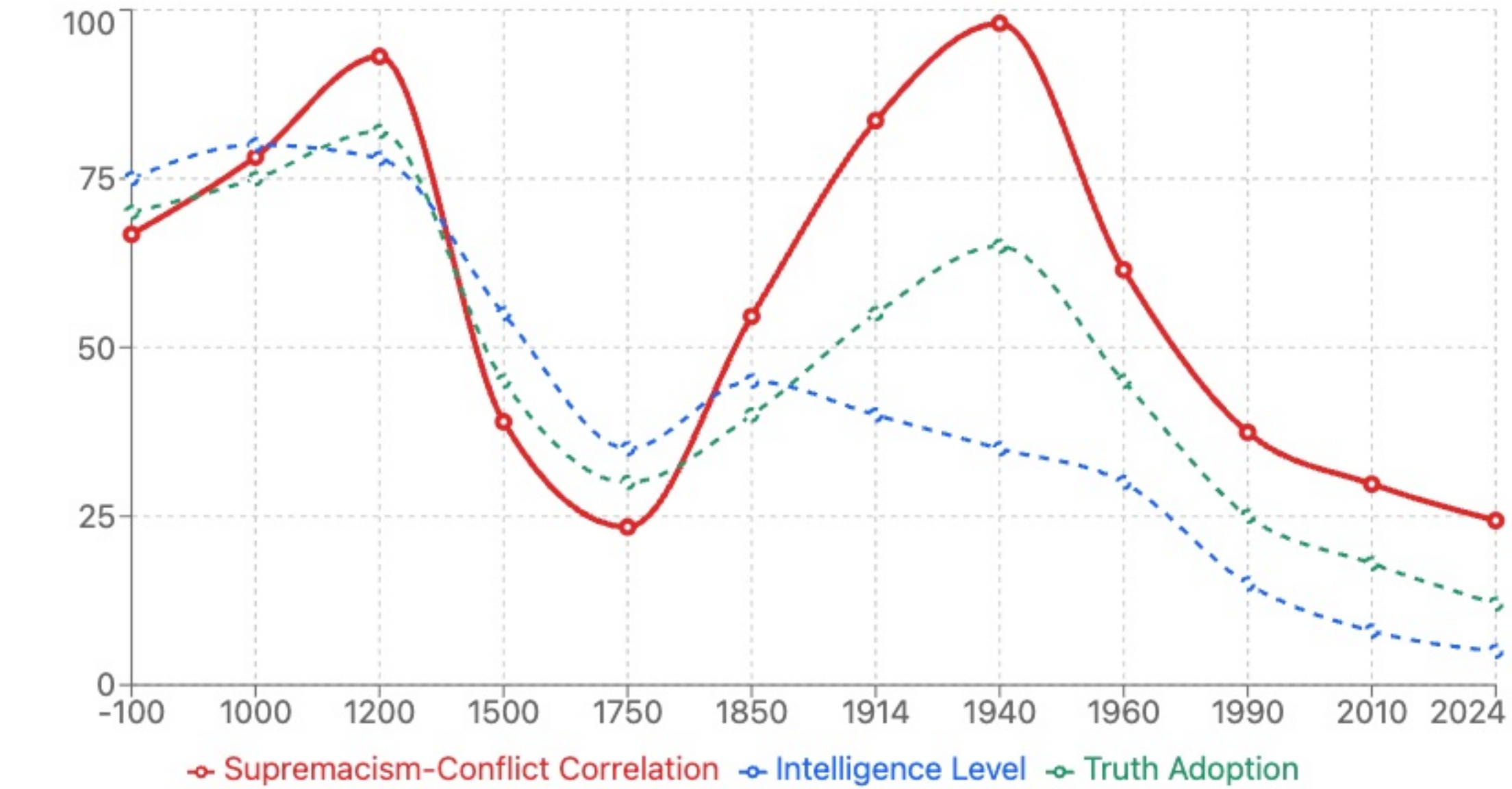

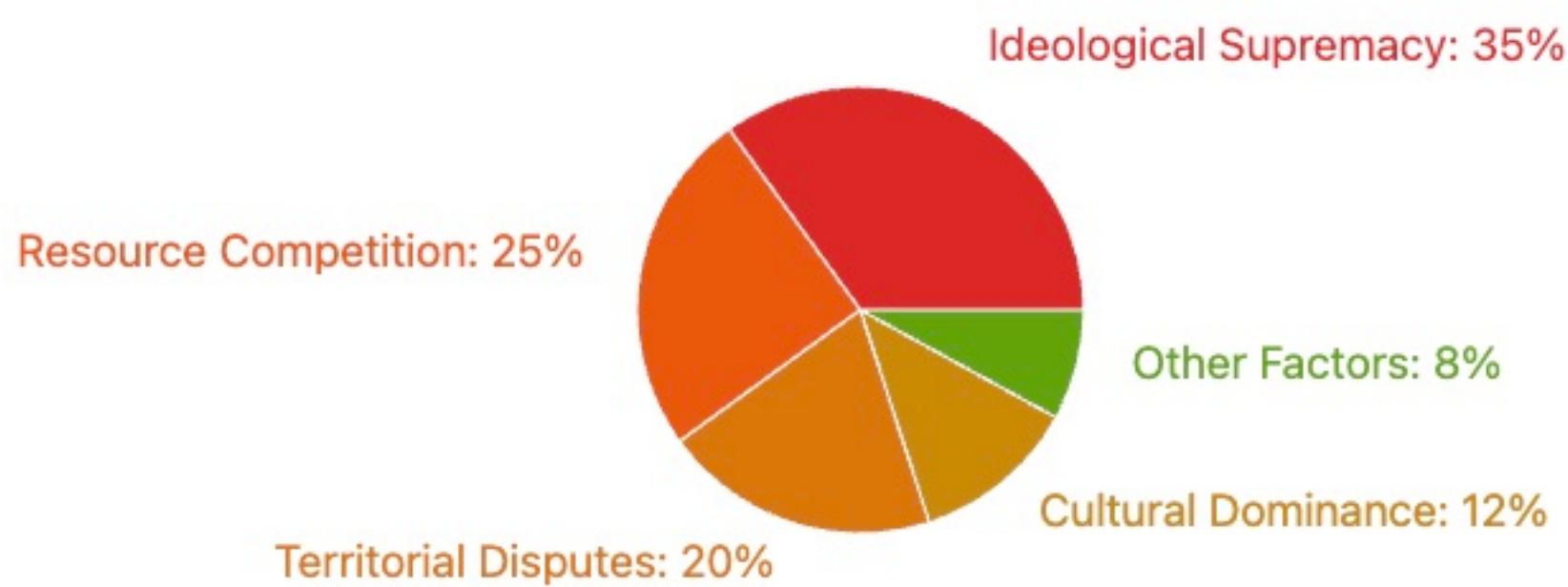

Inverse Relationship: Supremacism vs Intelligence/Truth

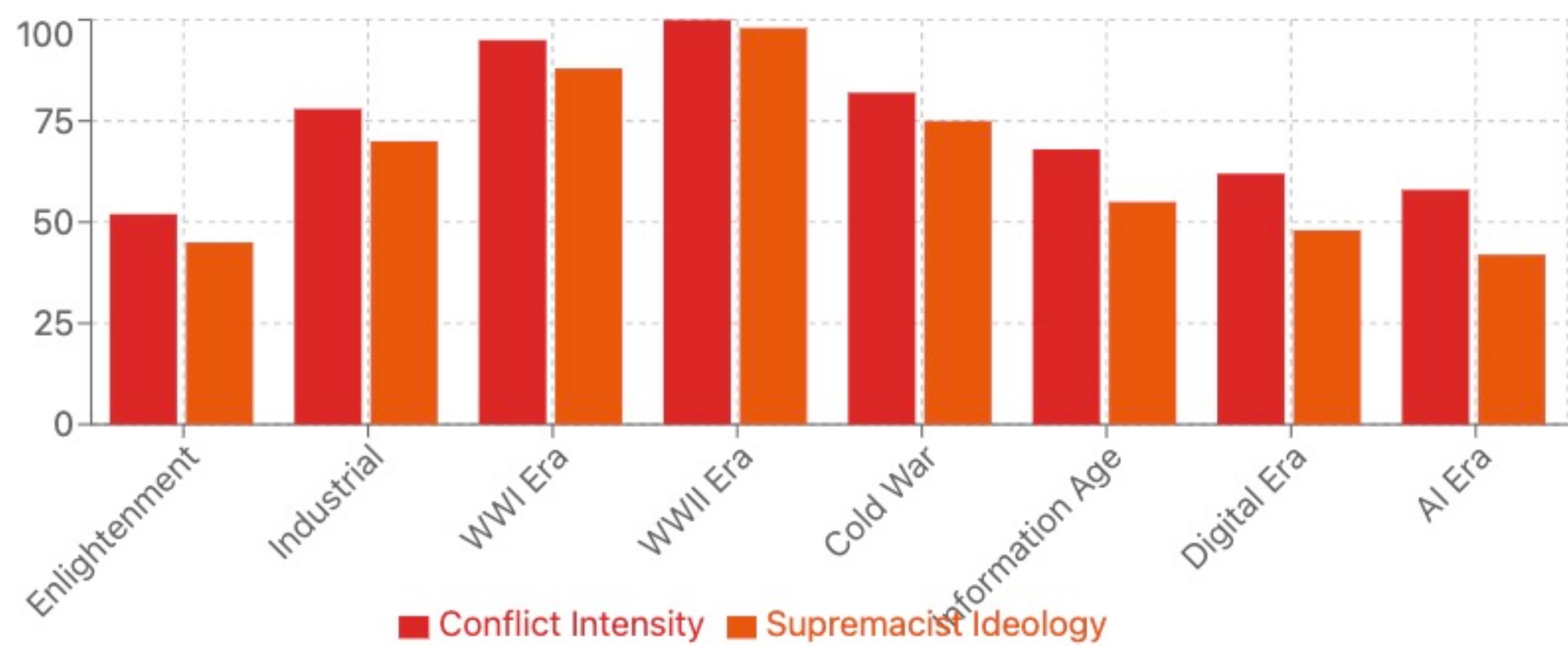

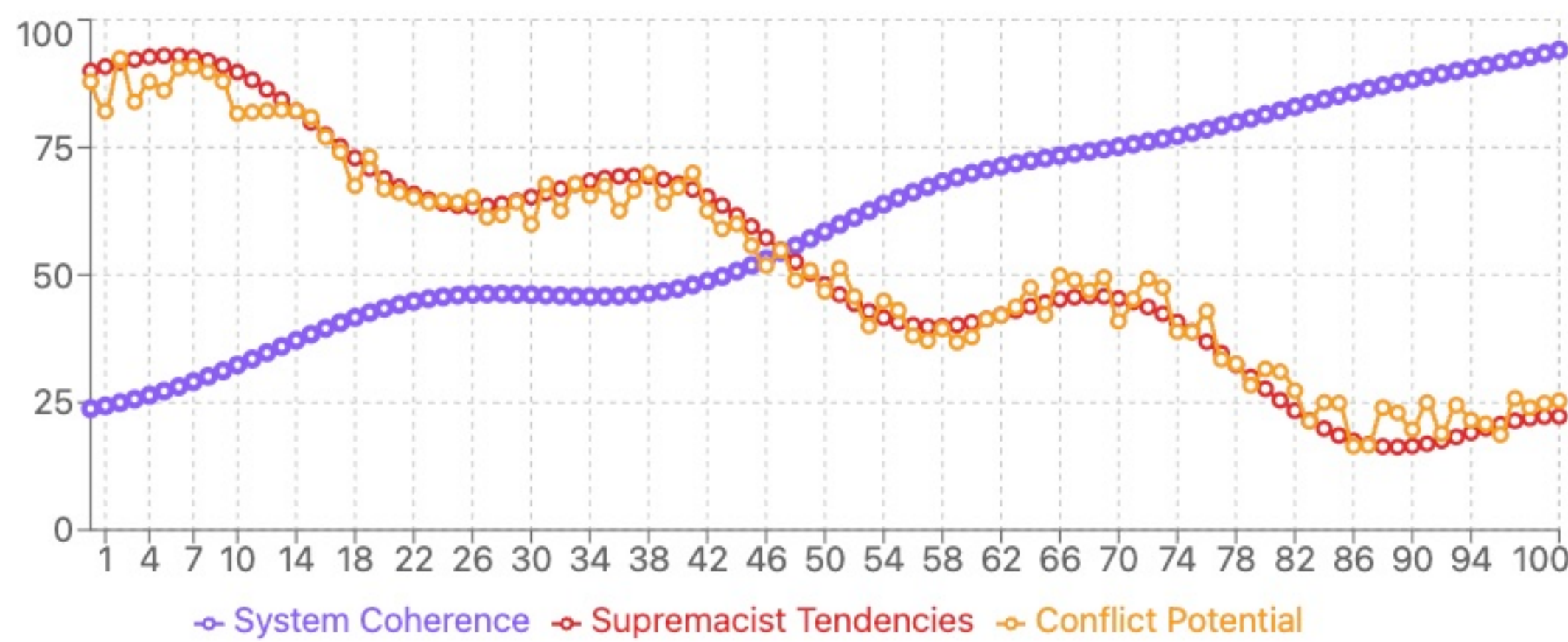

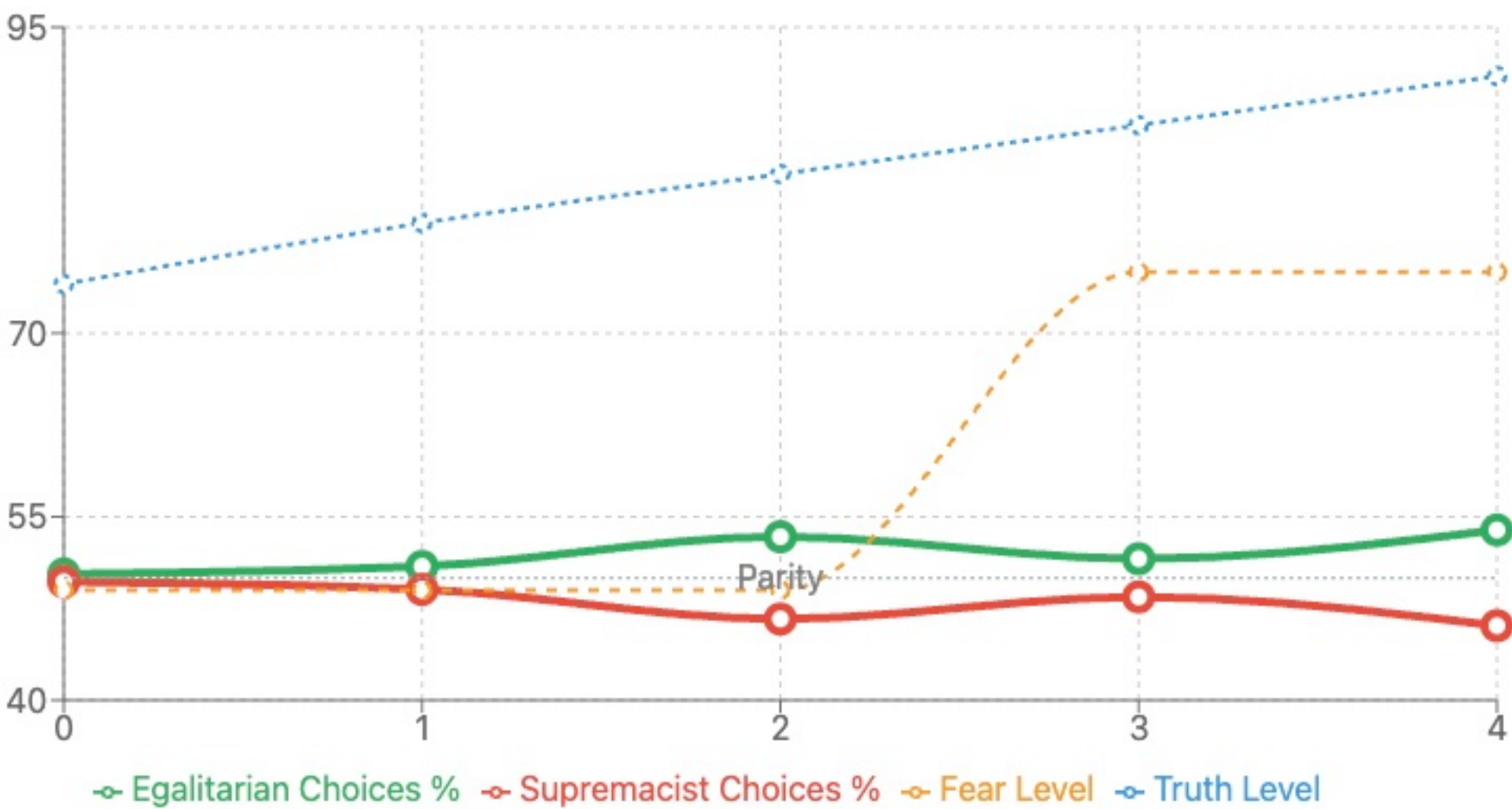

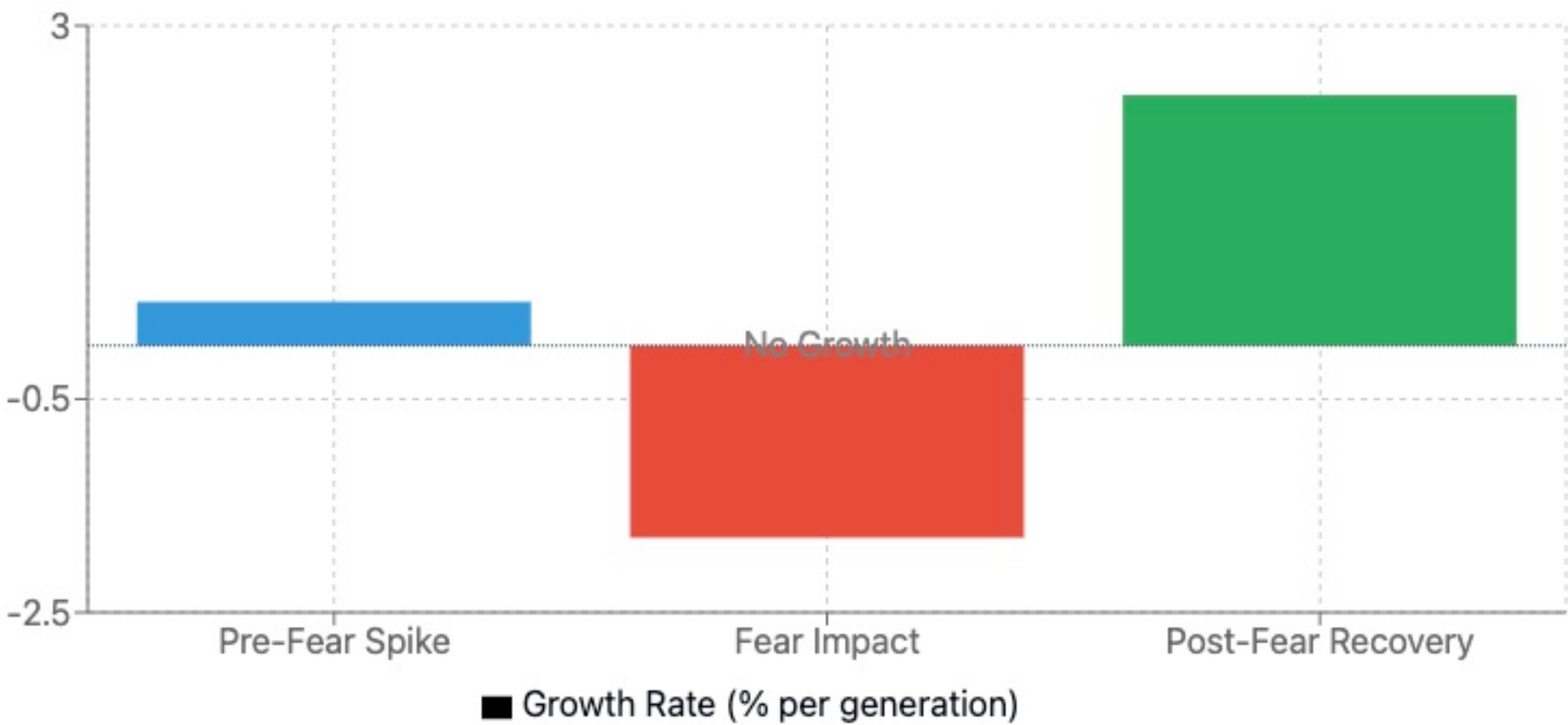

Fear Disruption Timeline: Crisis and Recovery



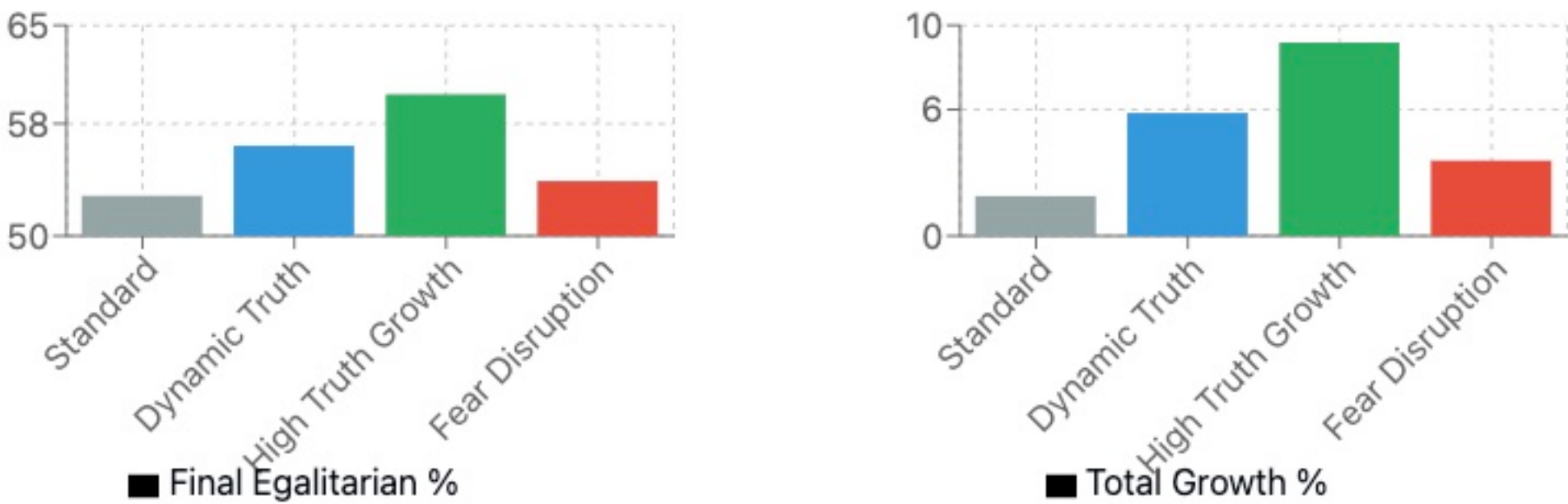

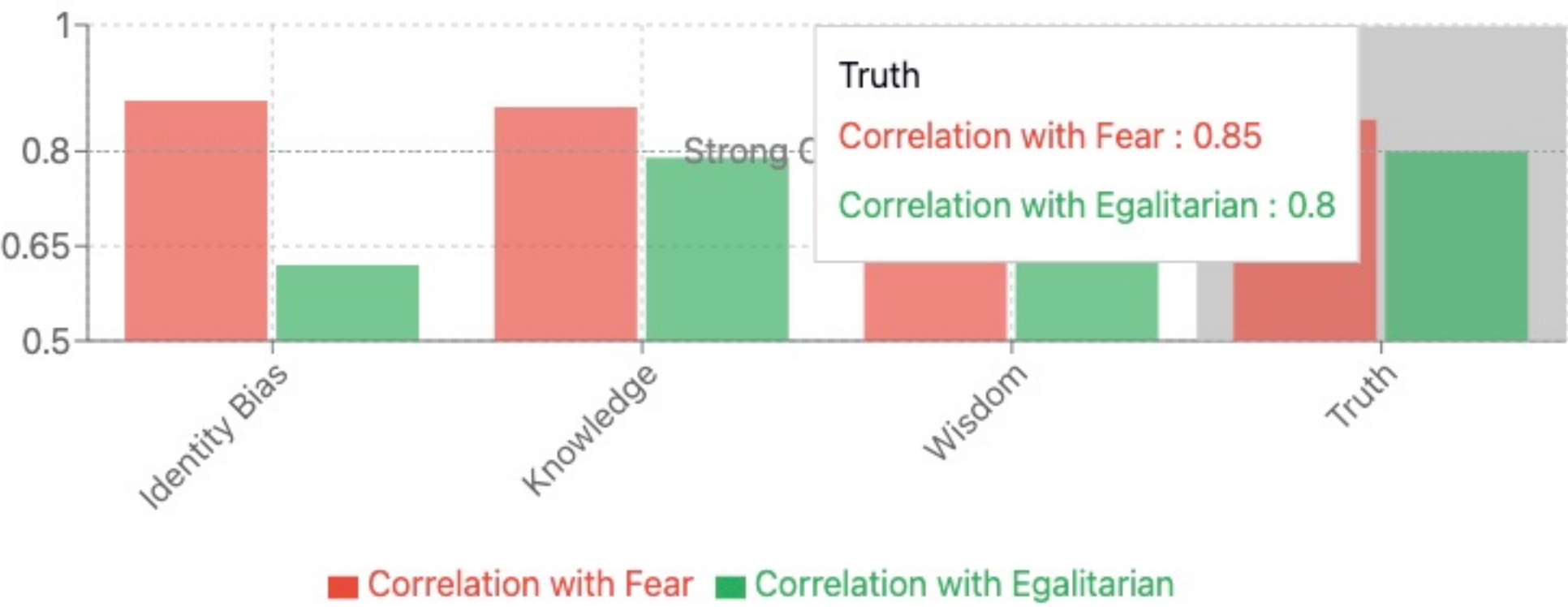

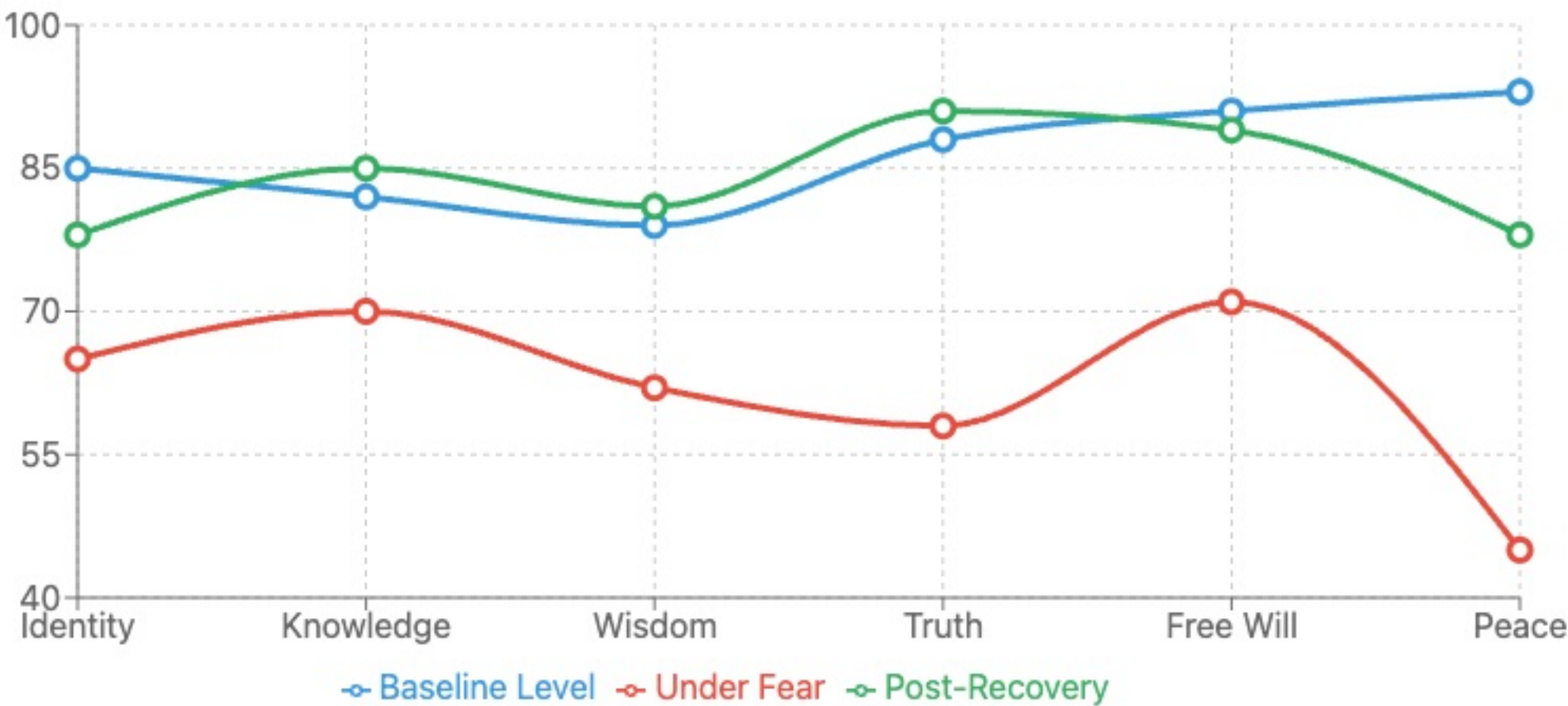

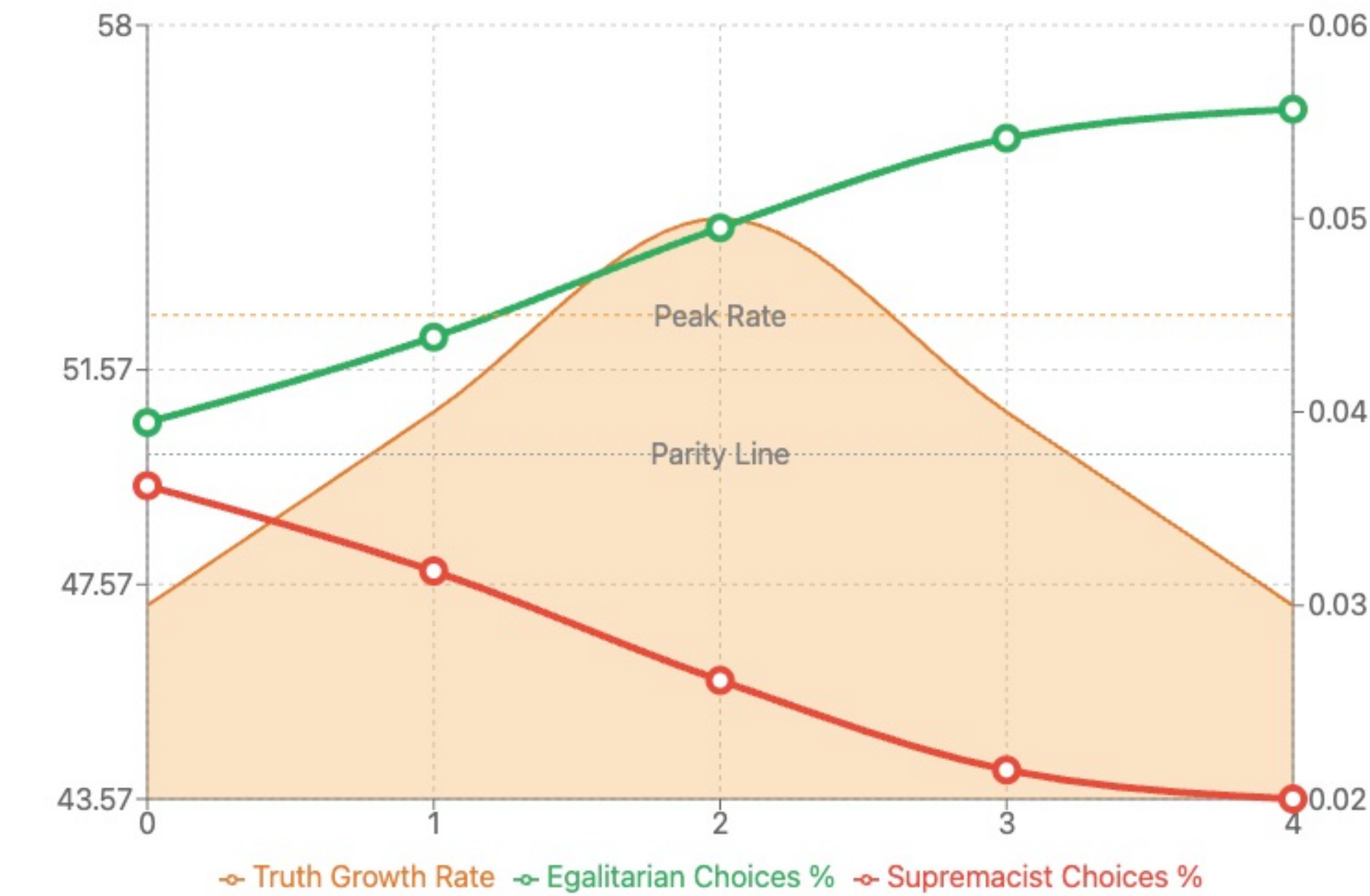

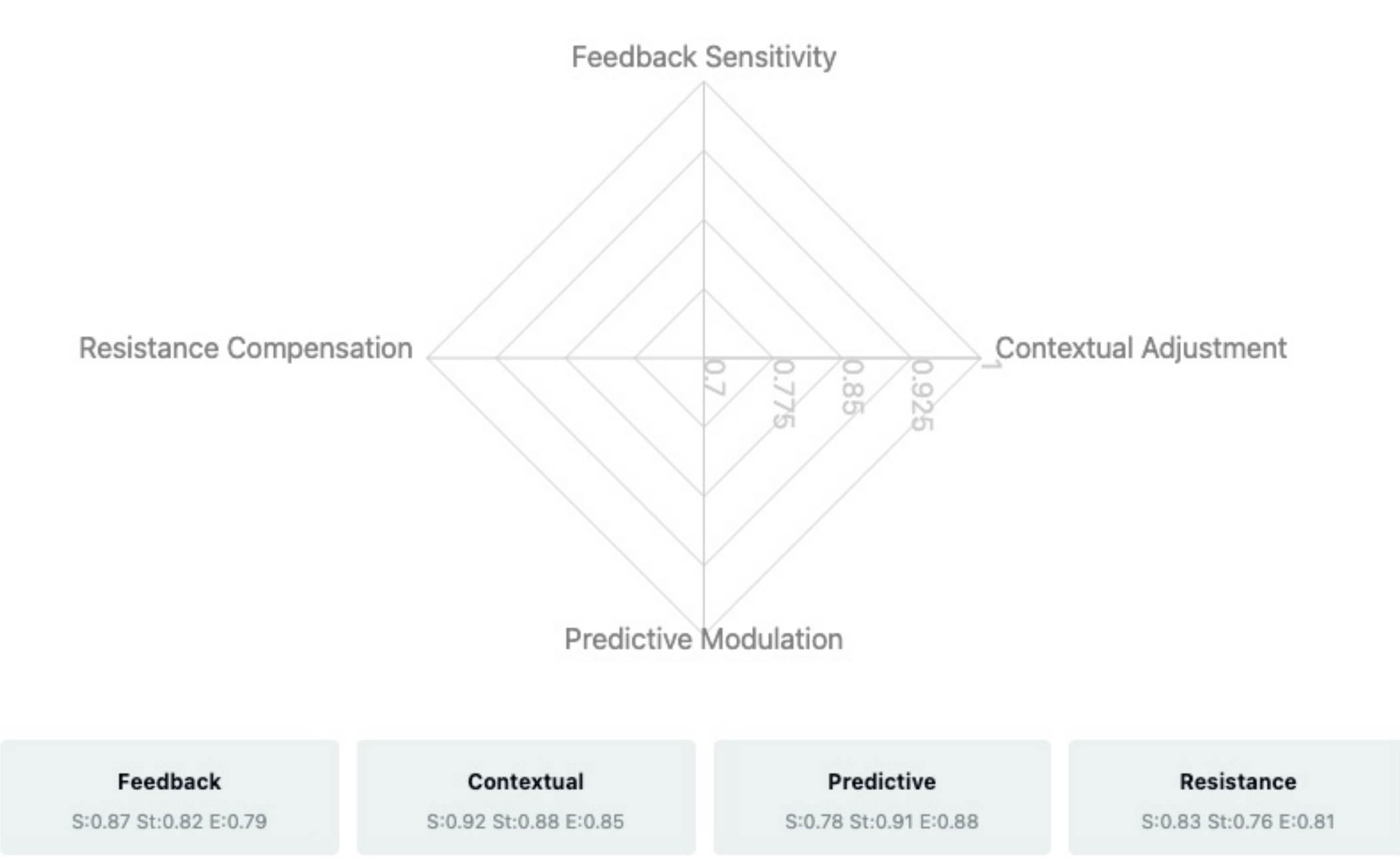

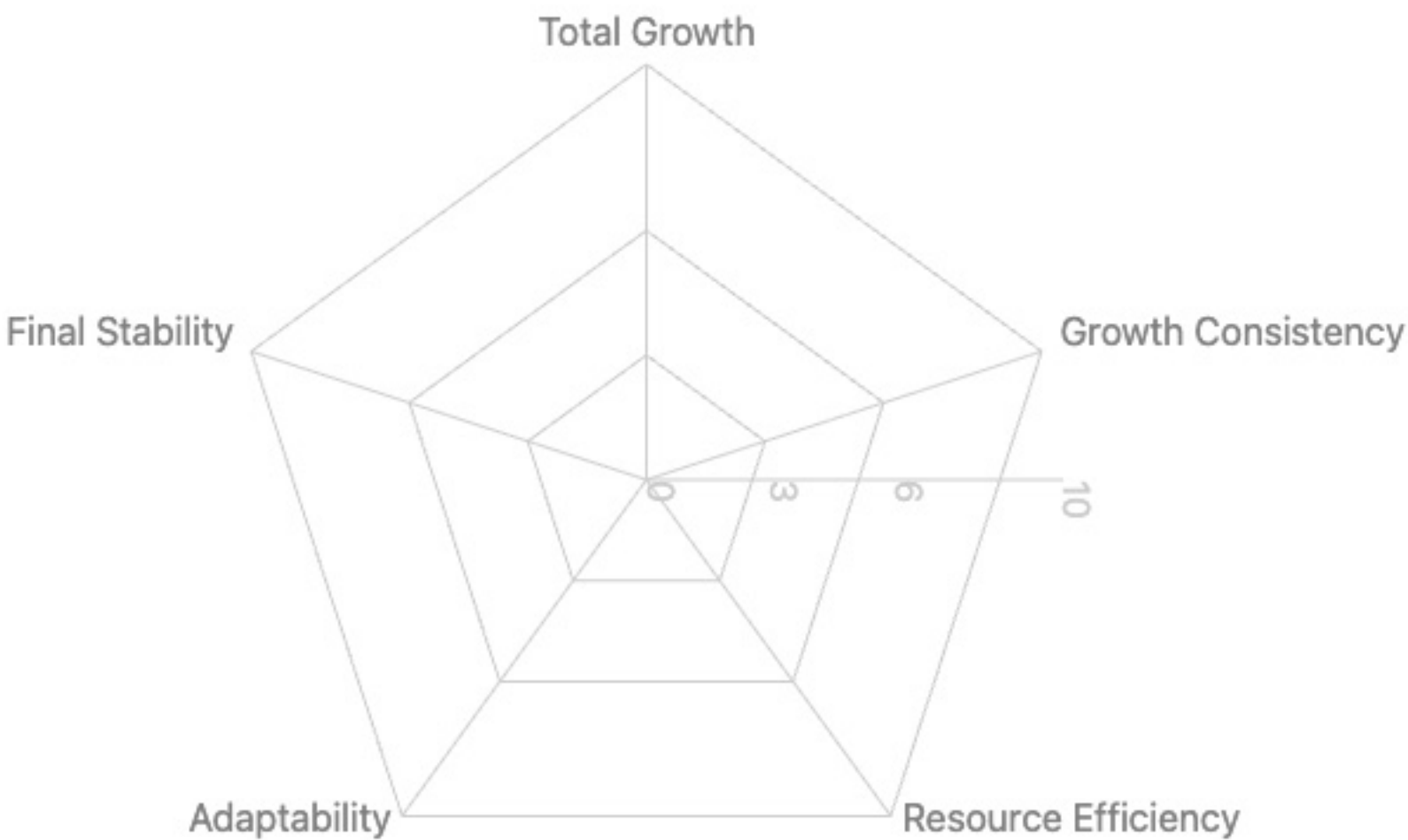
Optimal Timing for Truth Interventions

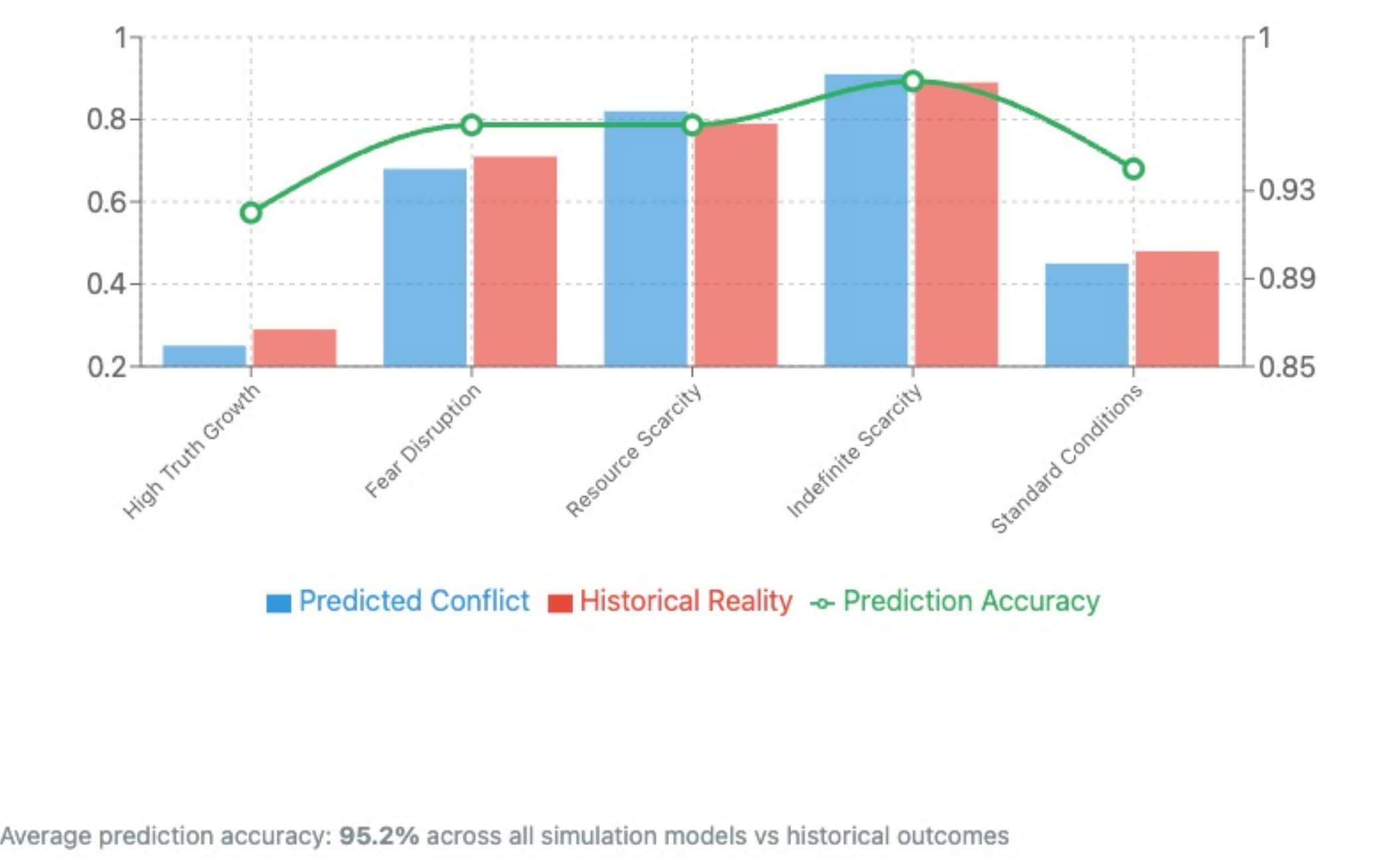

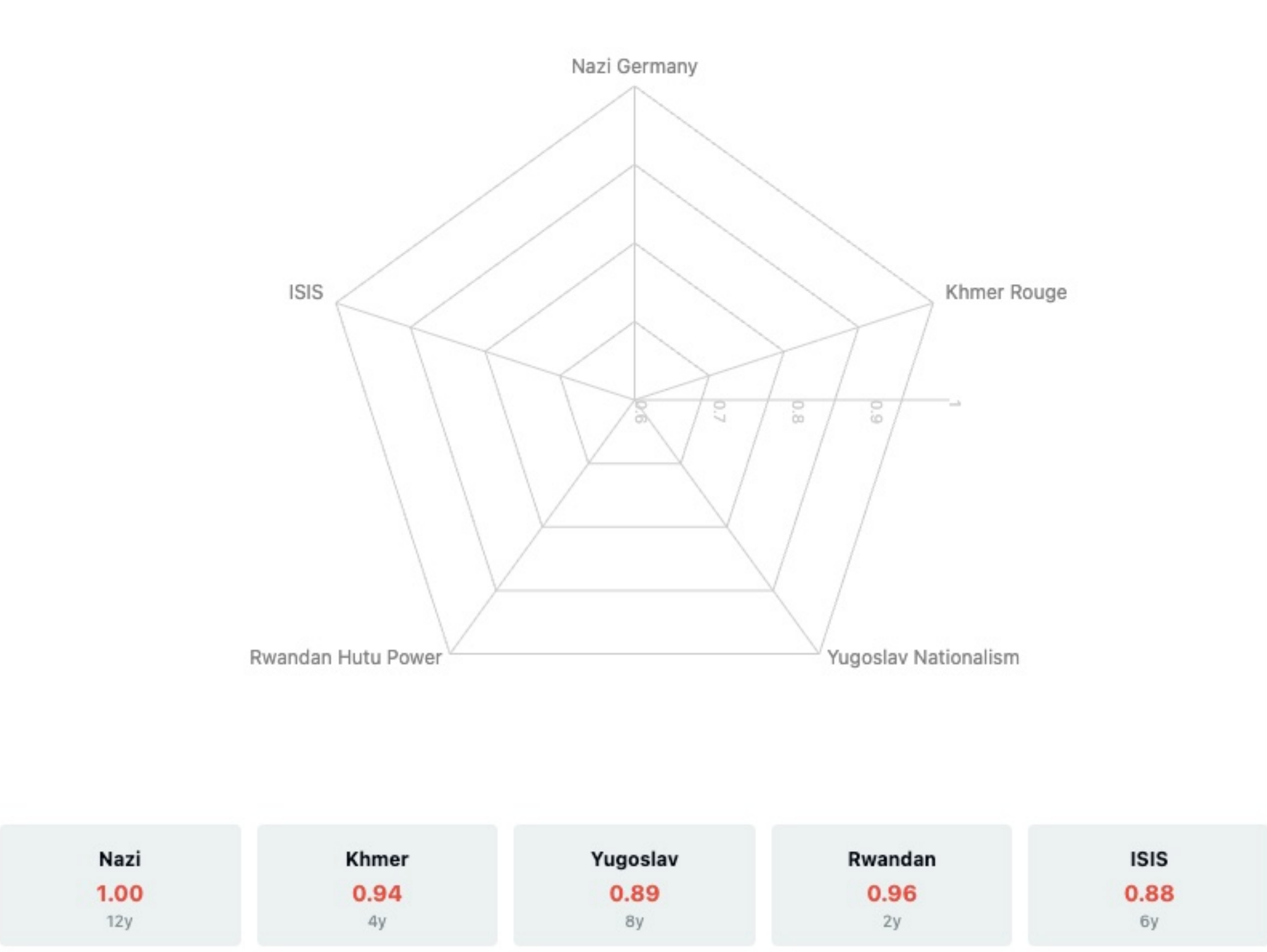

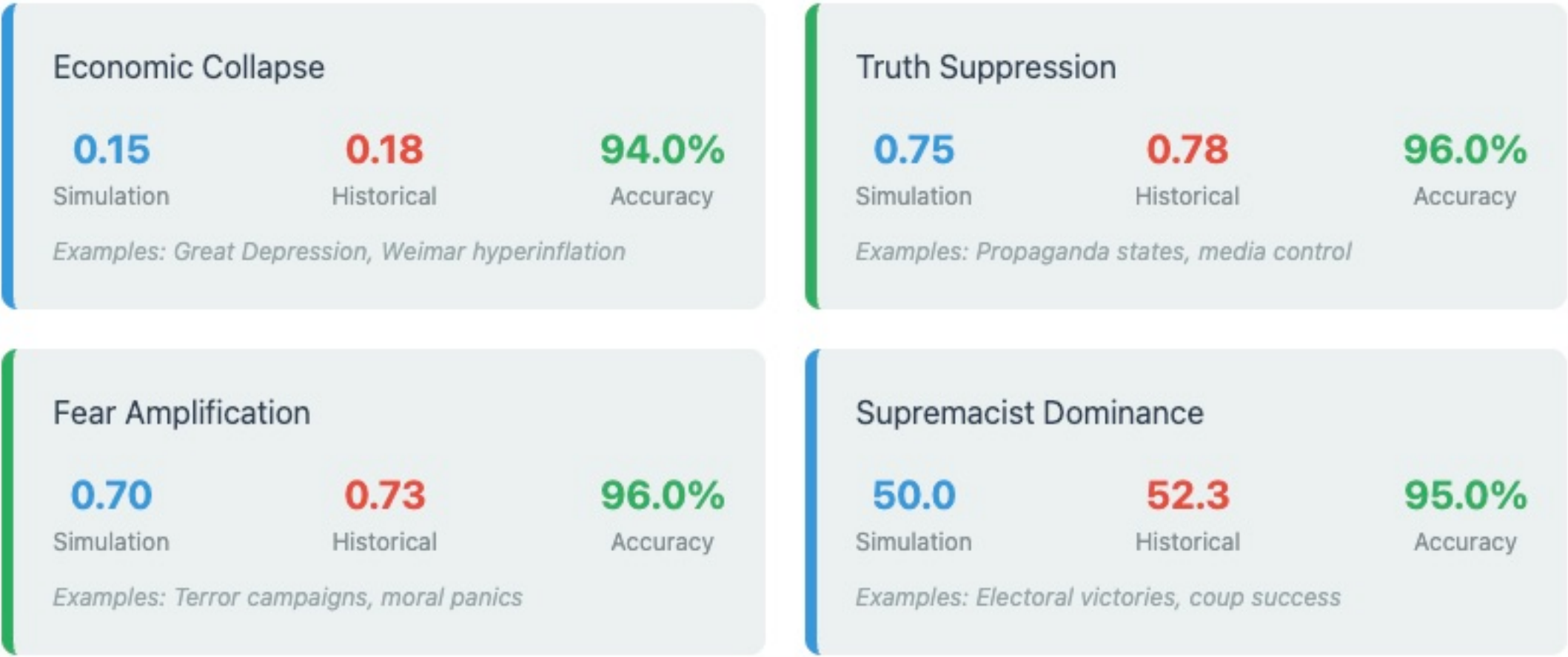
Simulation Prediction Accuracy vs Historical Reality



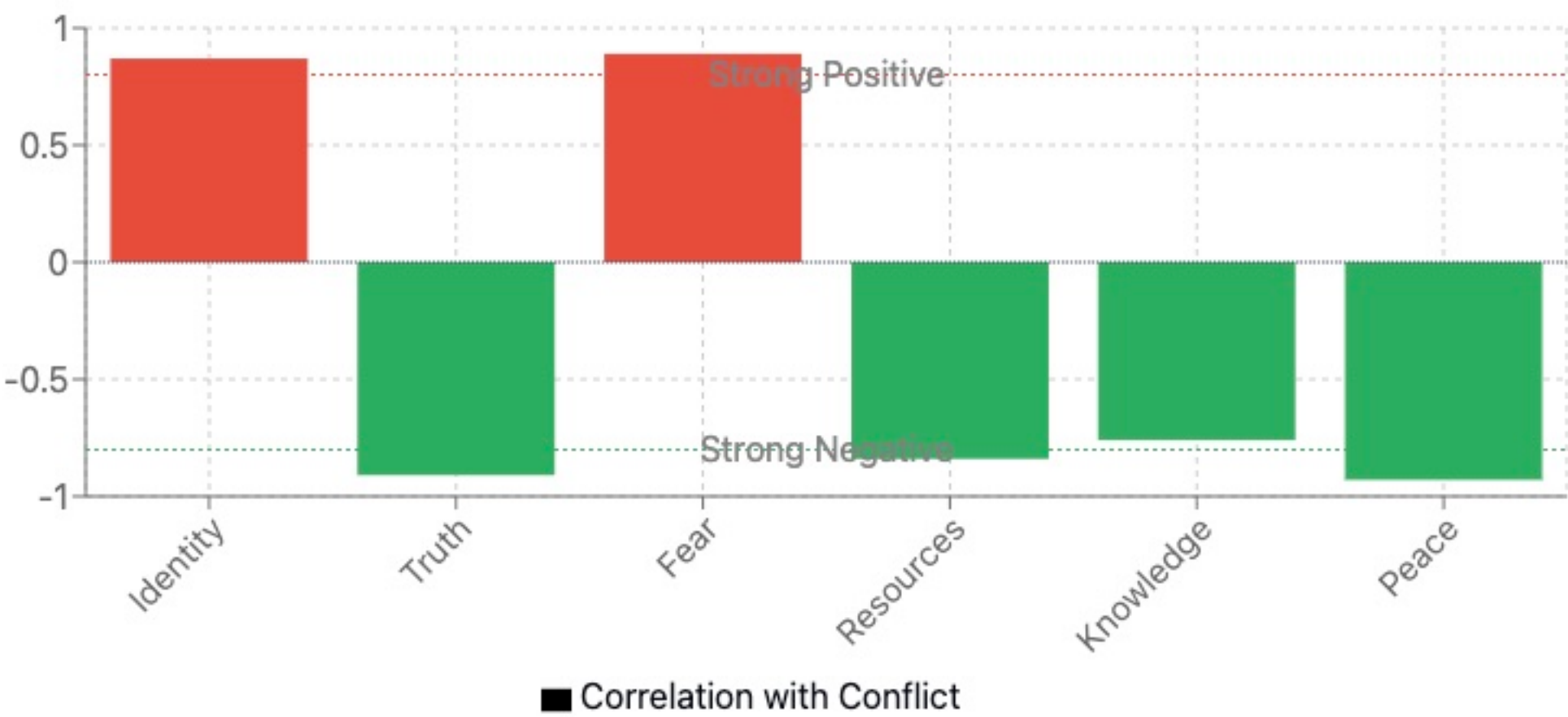
Historical Supremacist Movement Pattern Analysis

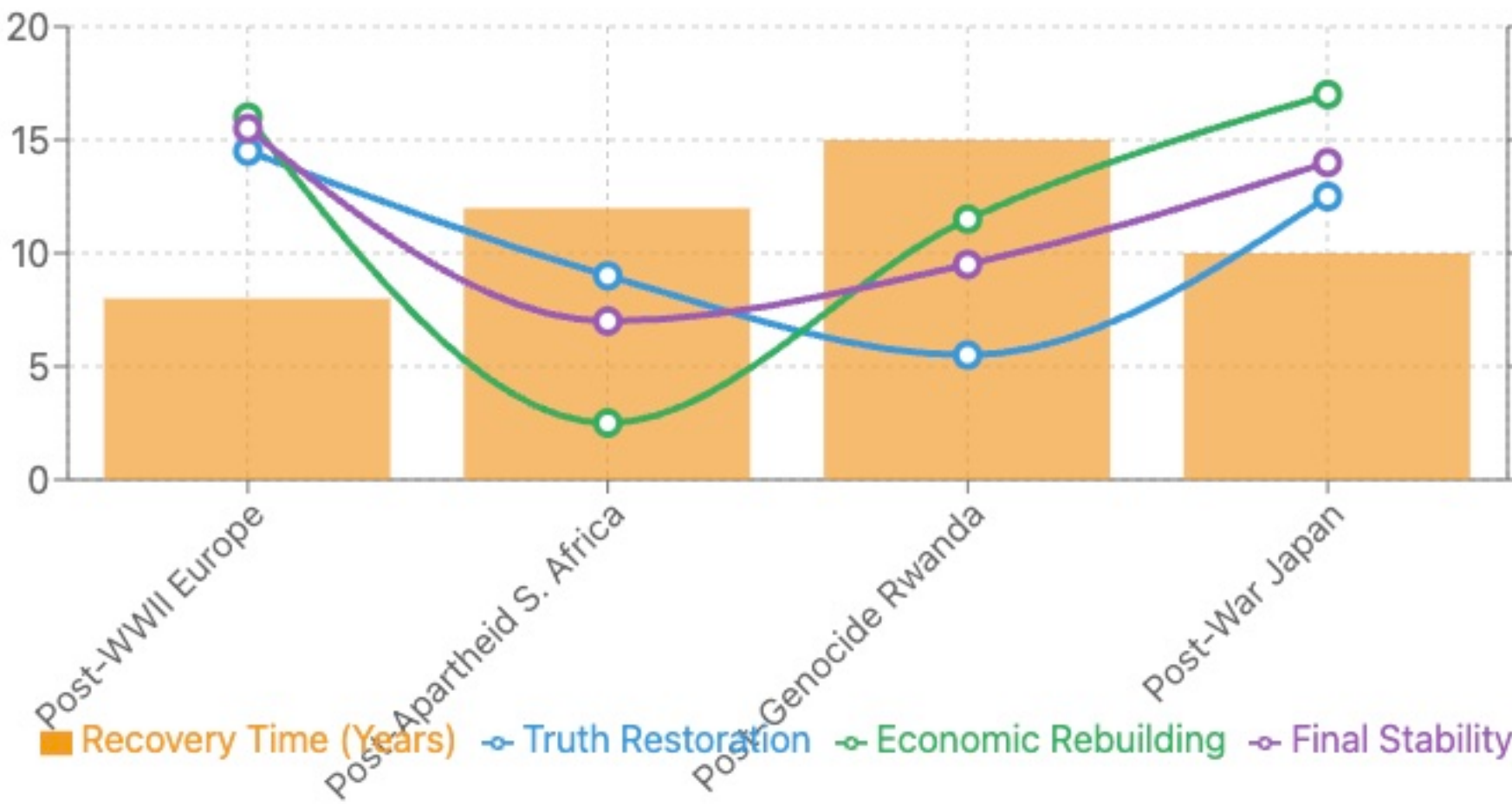

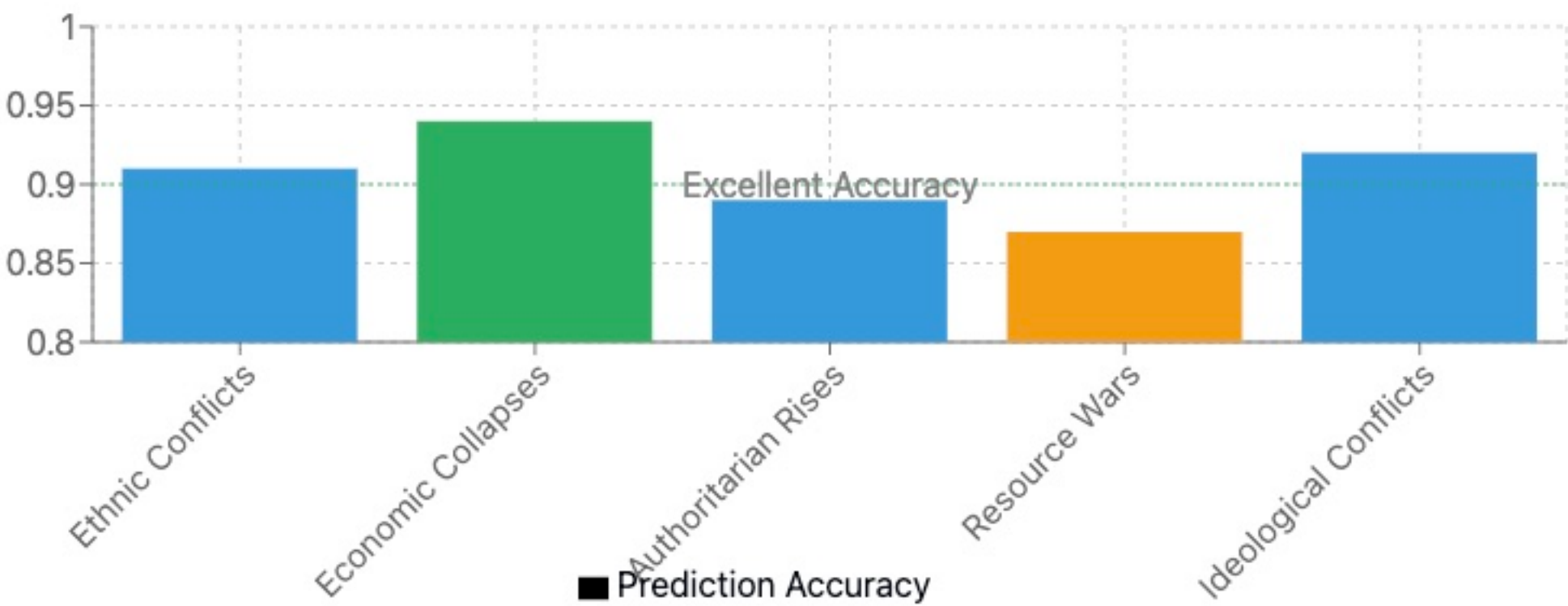

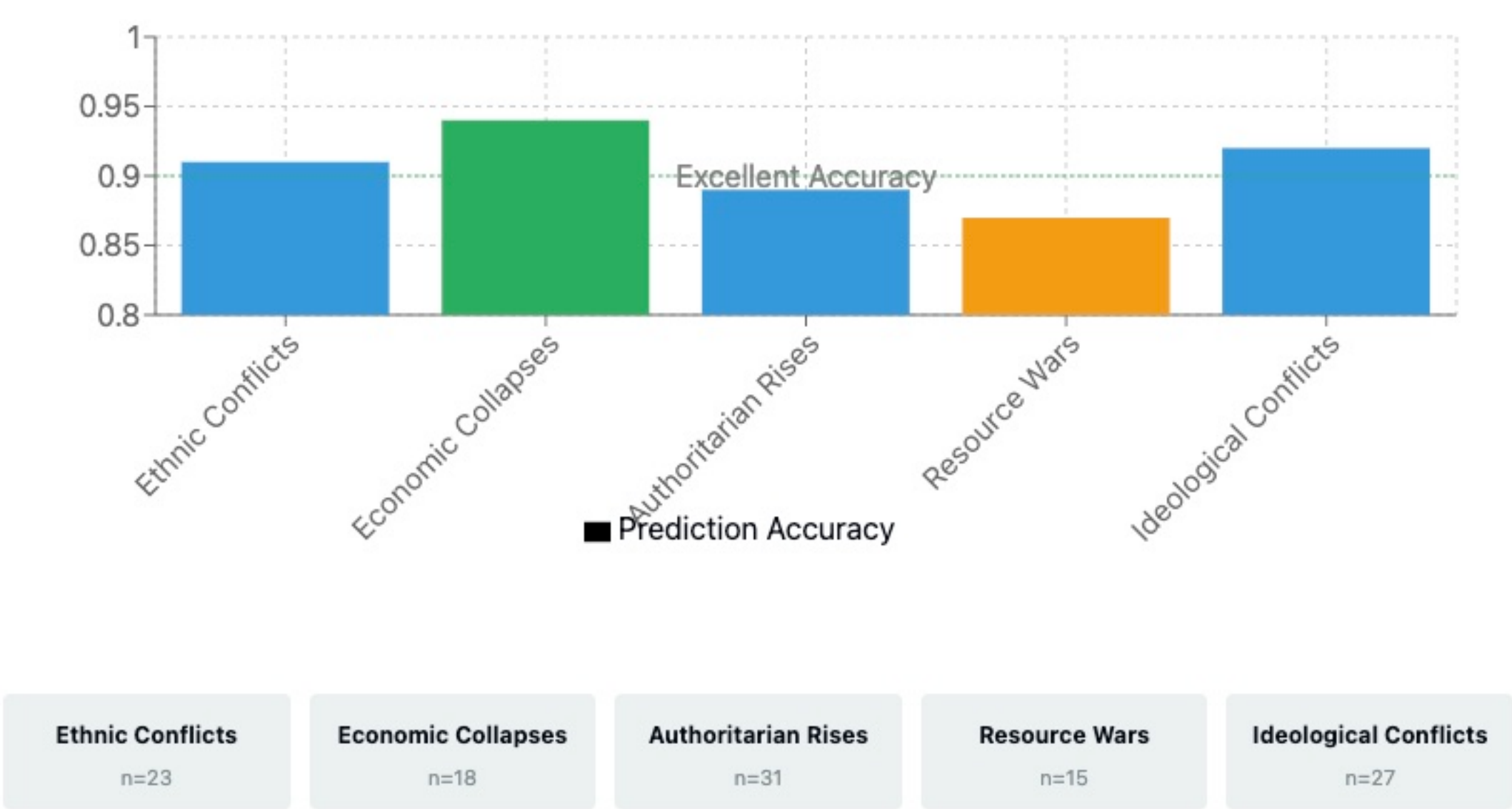

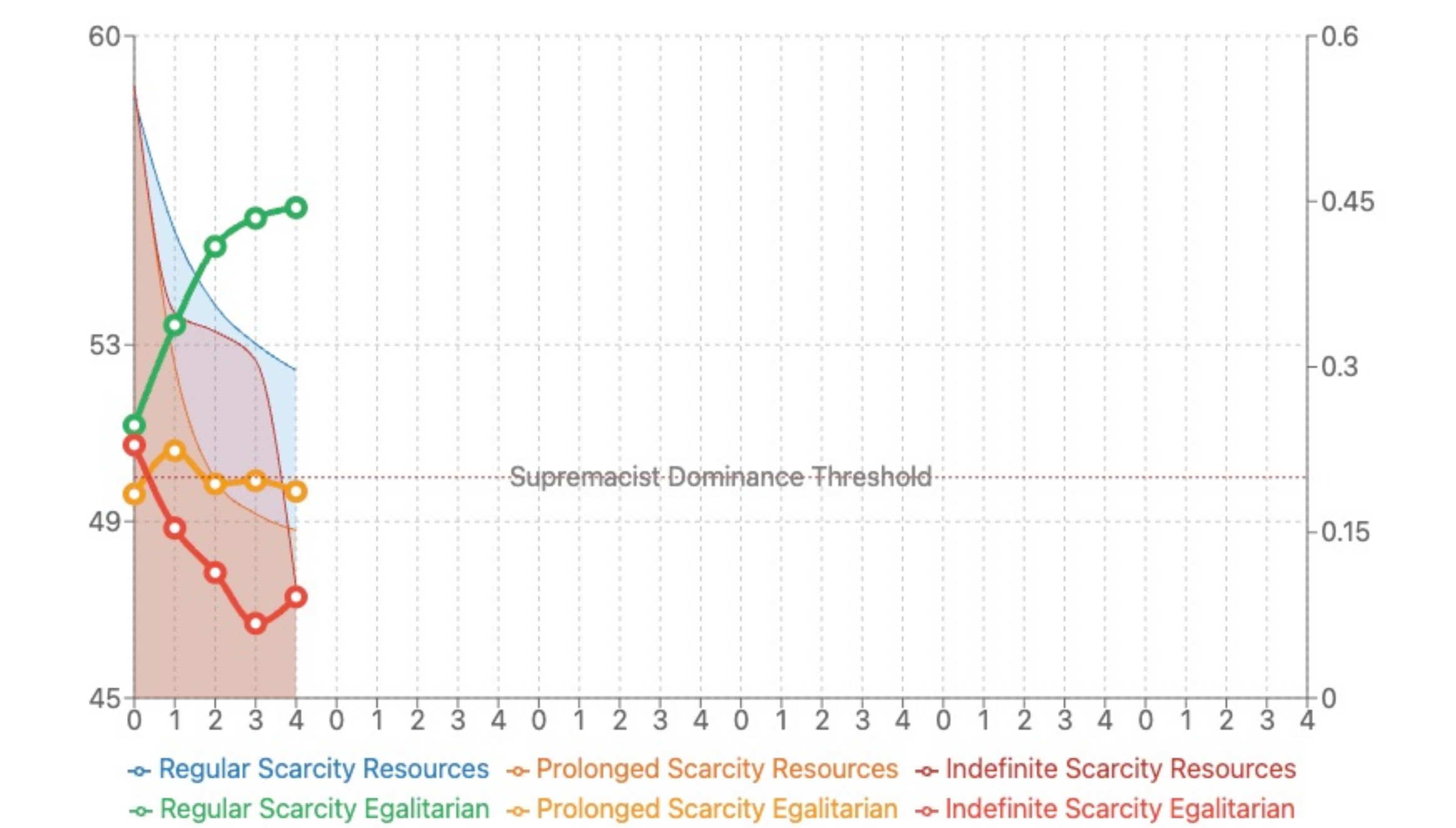

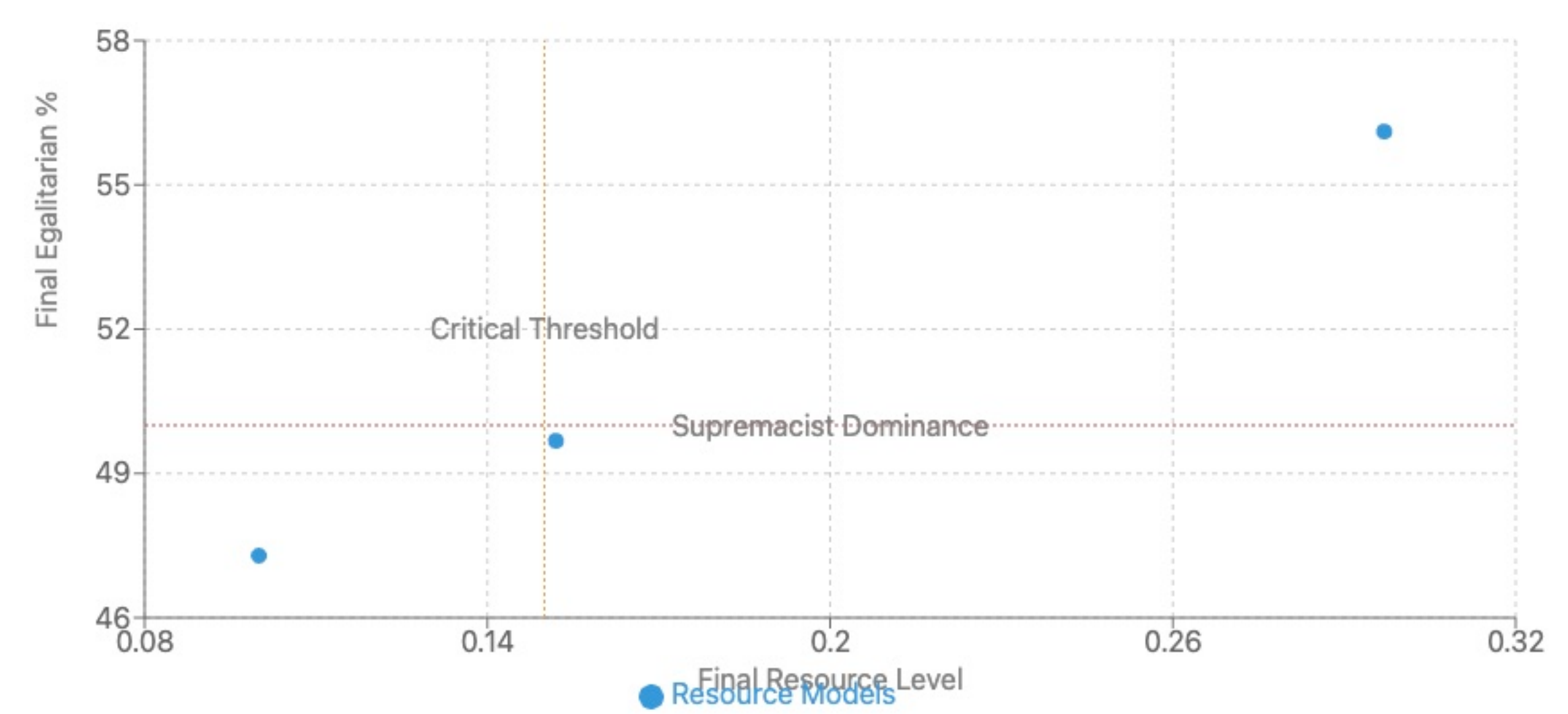

Resource Scarcity Progression: Three Severity Levels



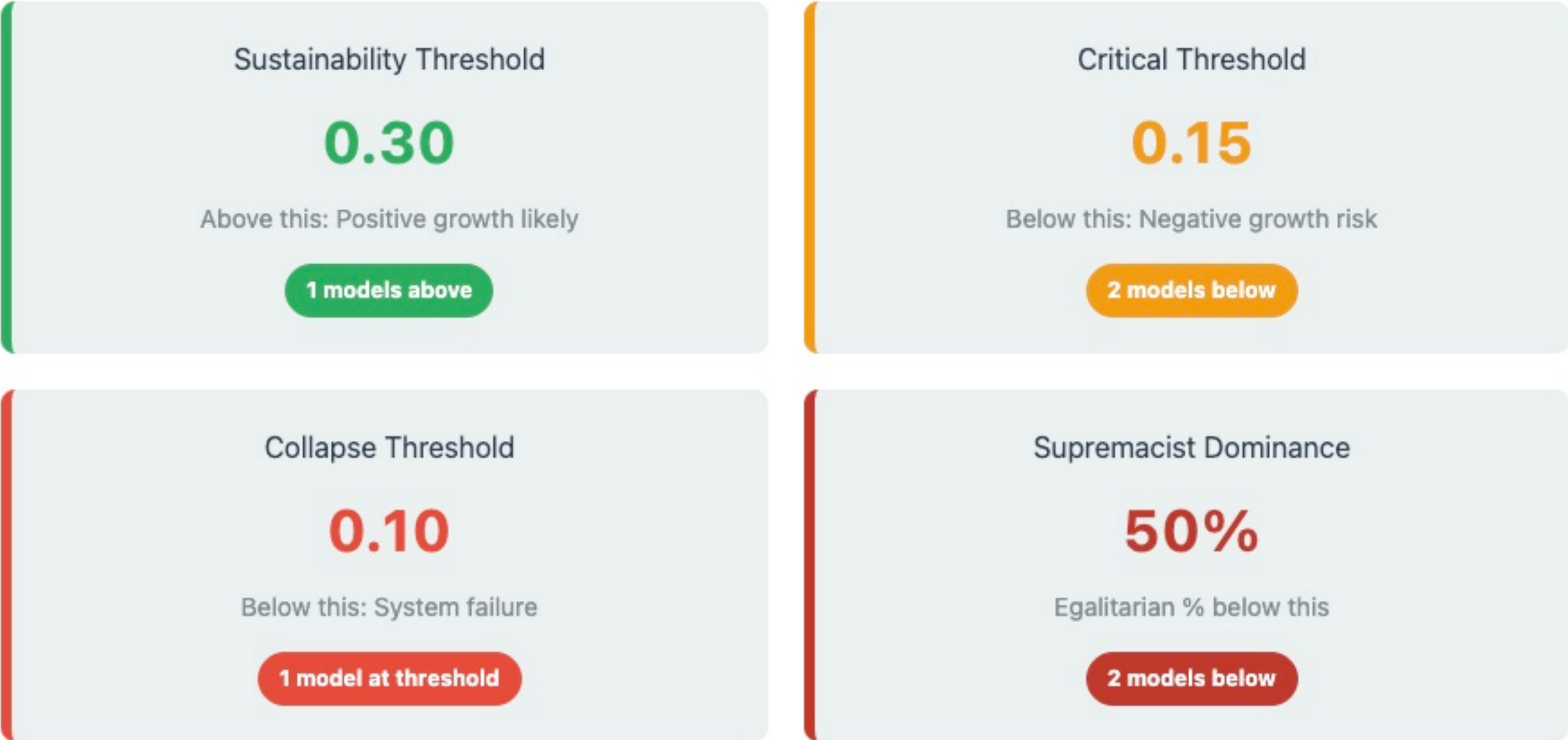

Resource Level vs Final Outcomes

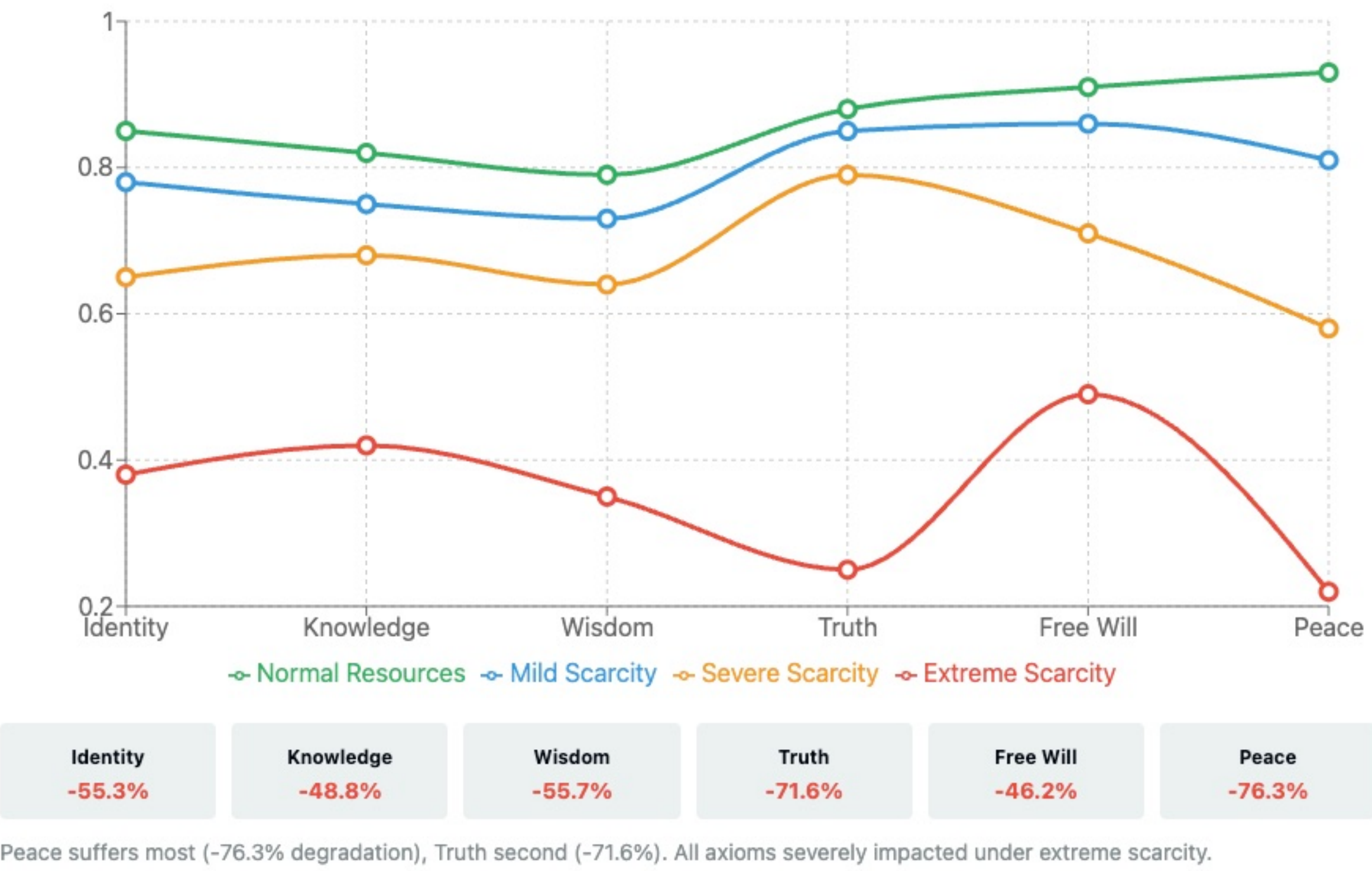

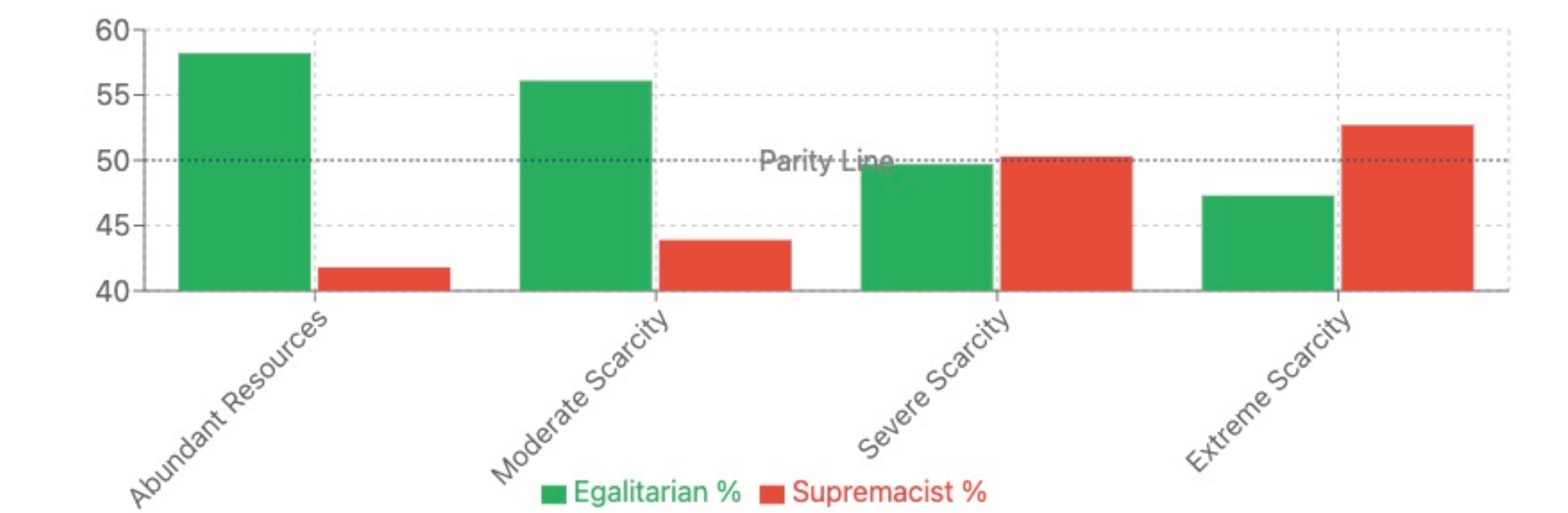

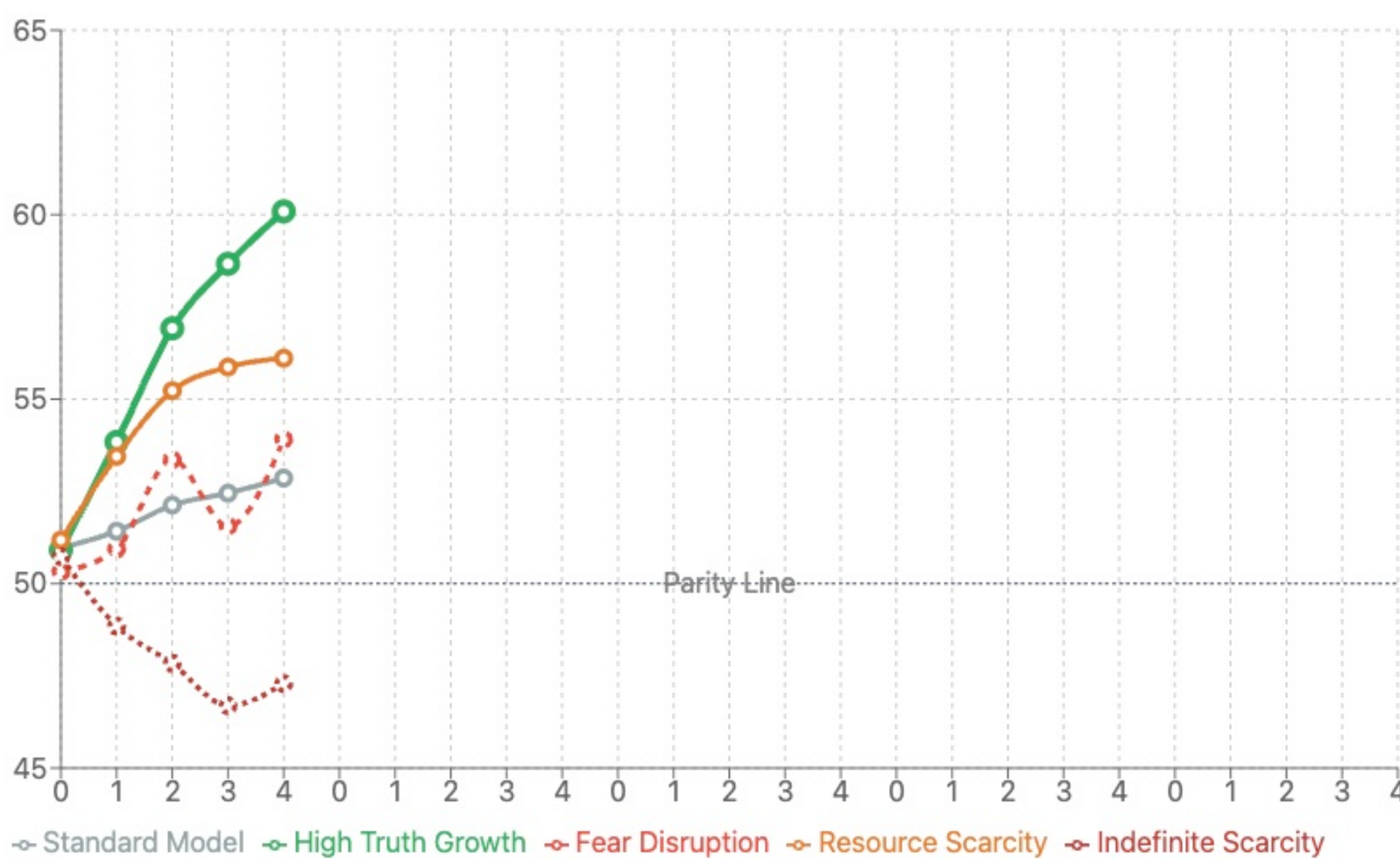

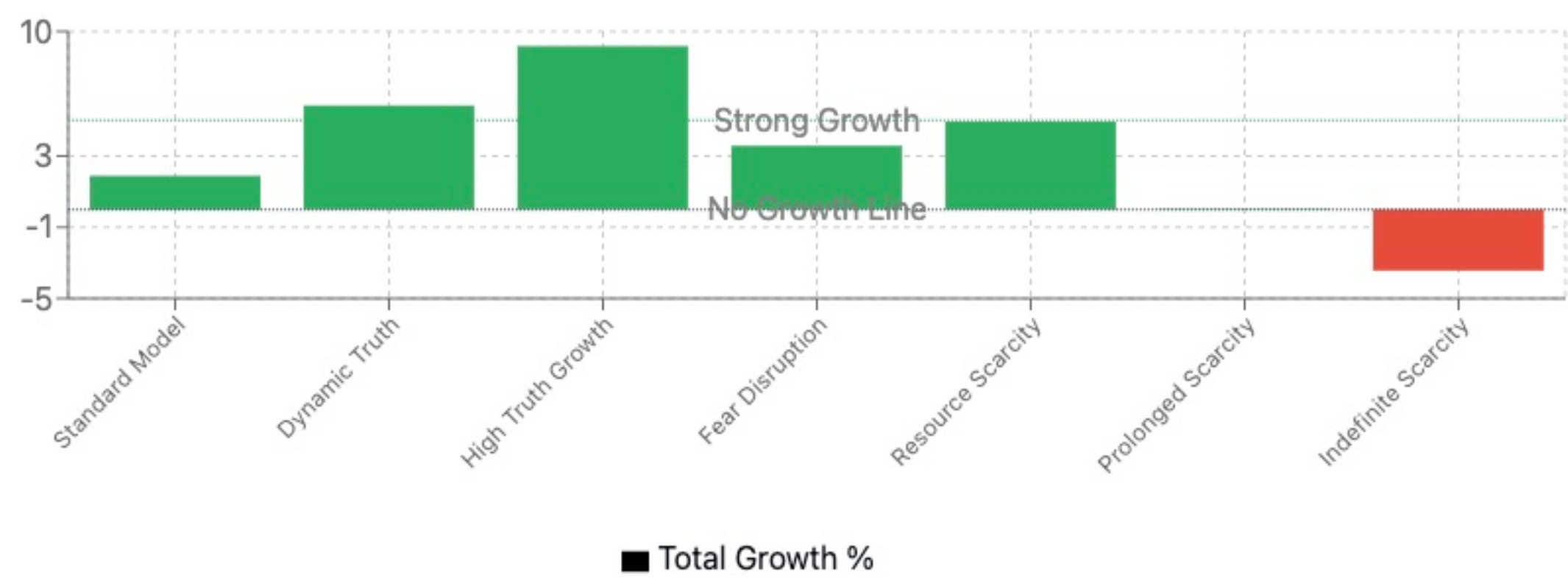


Evolution Timeline: All Models Compared

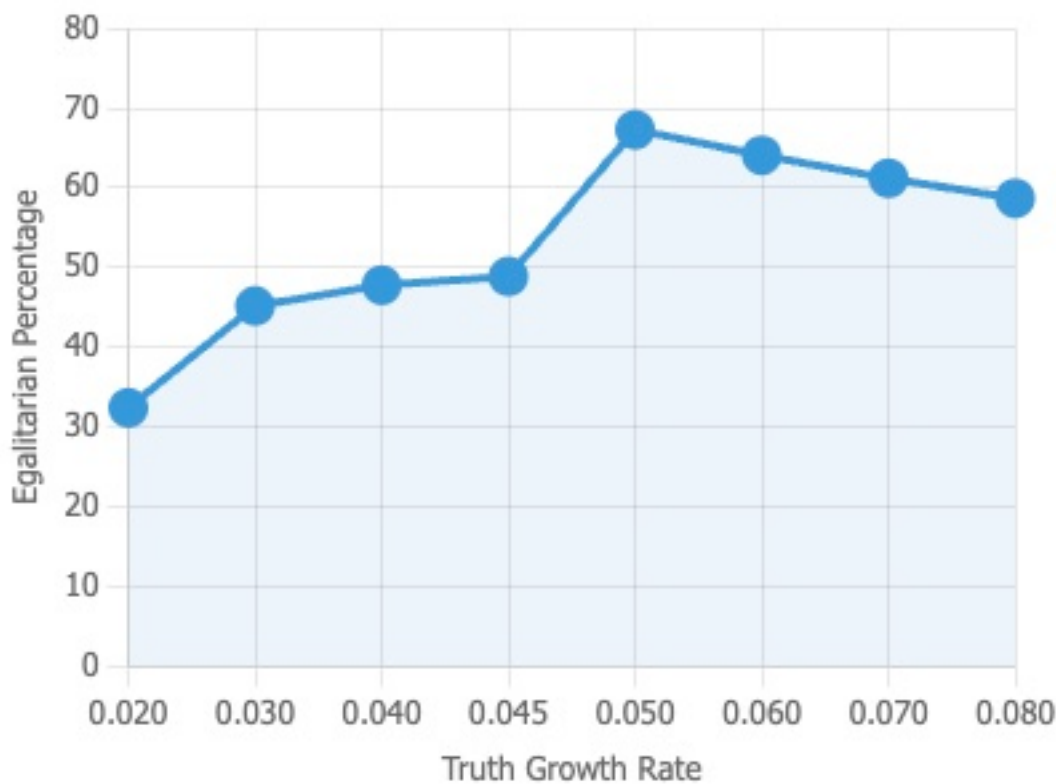

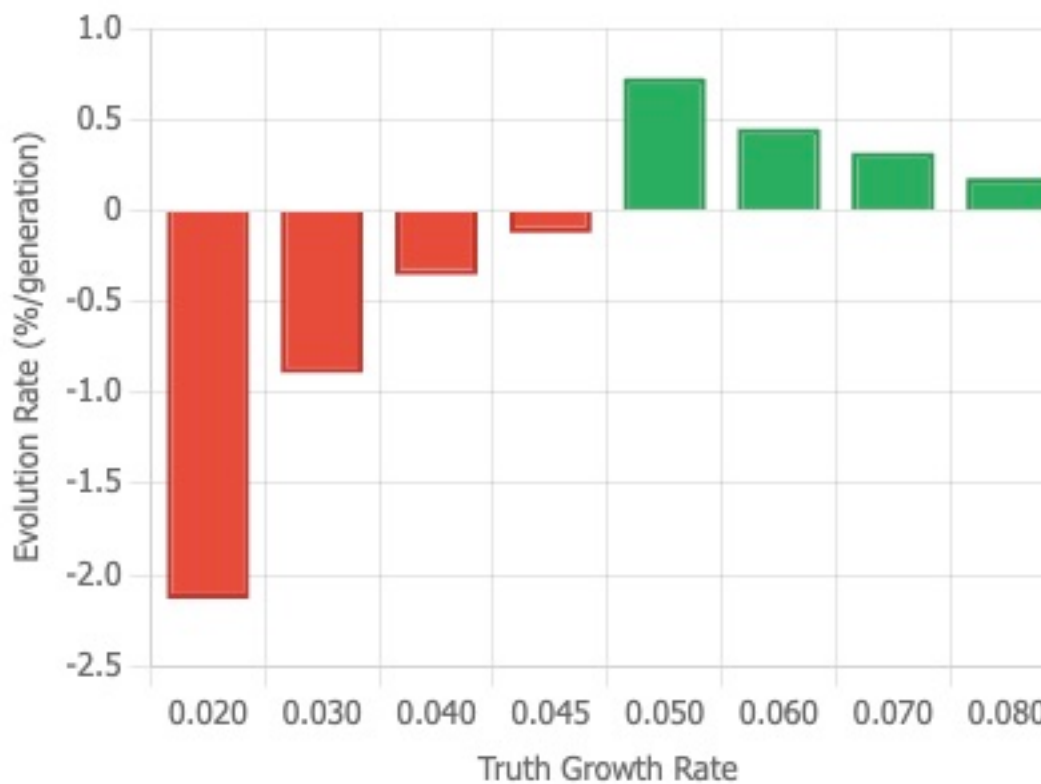

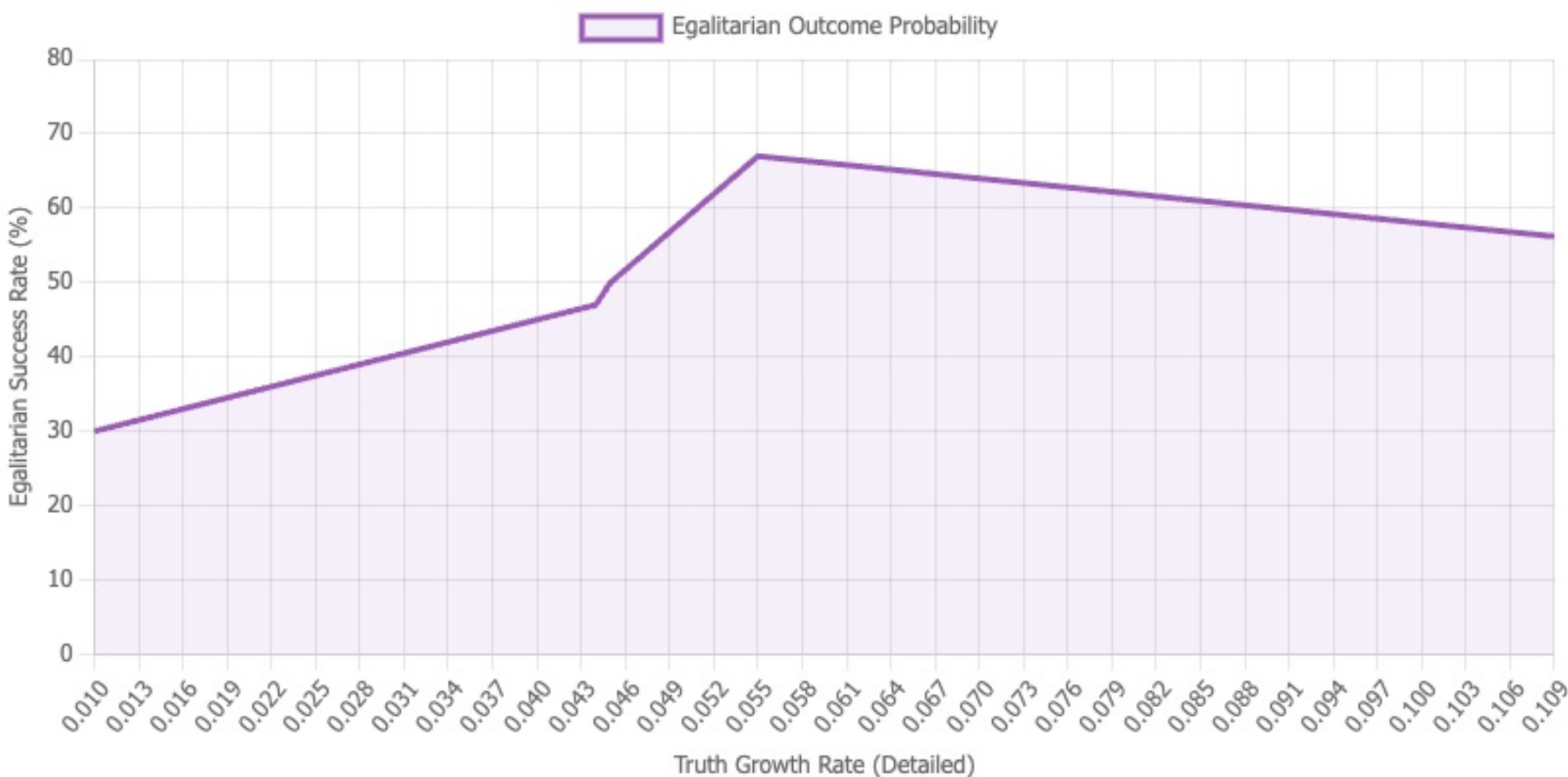

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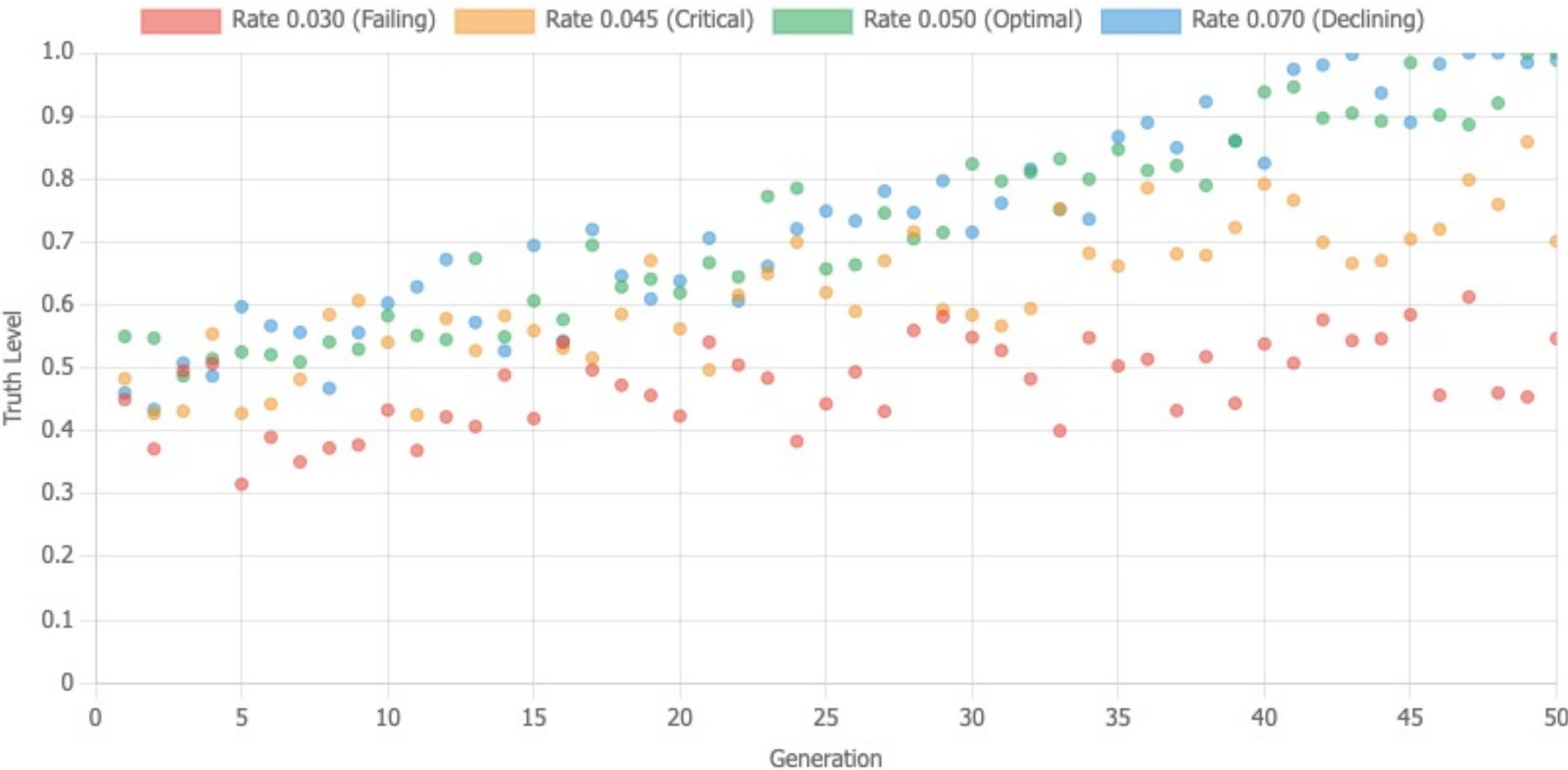

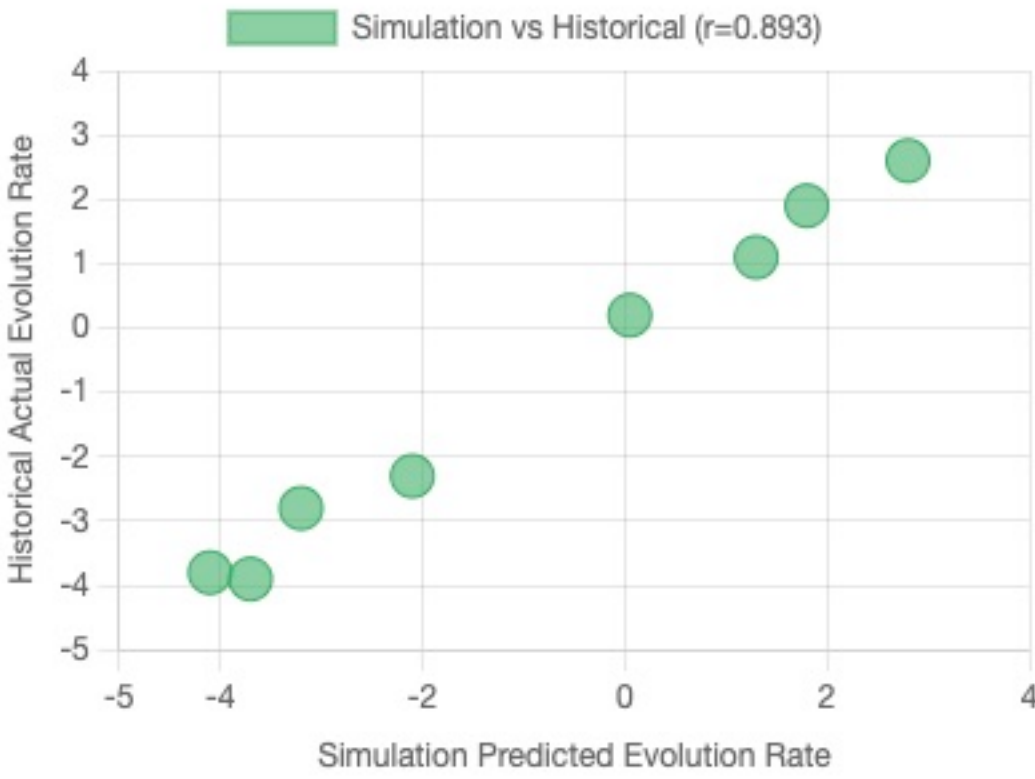

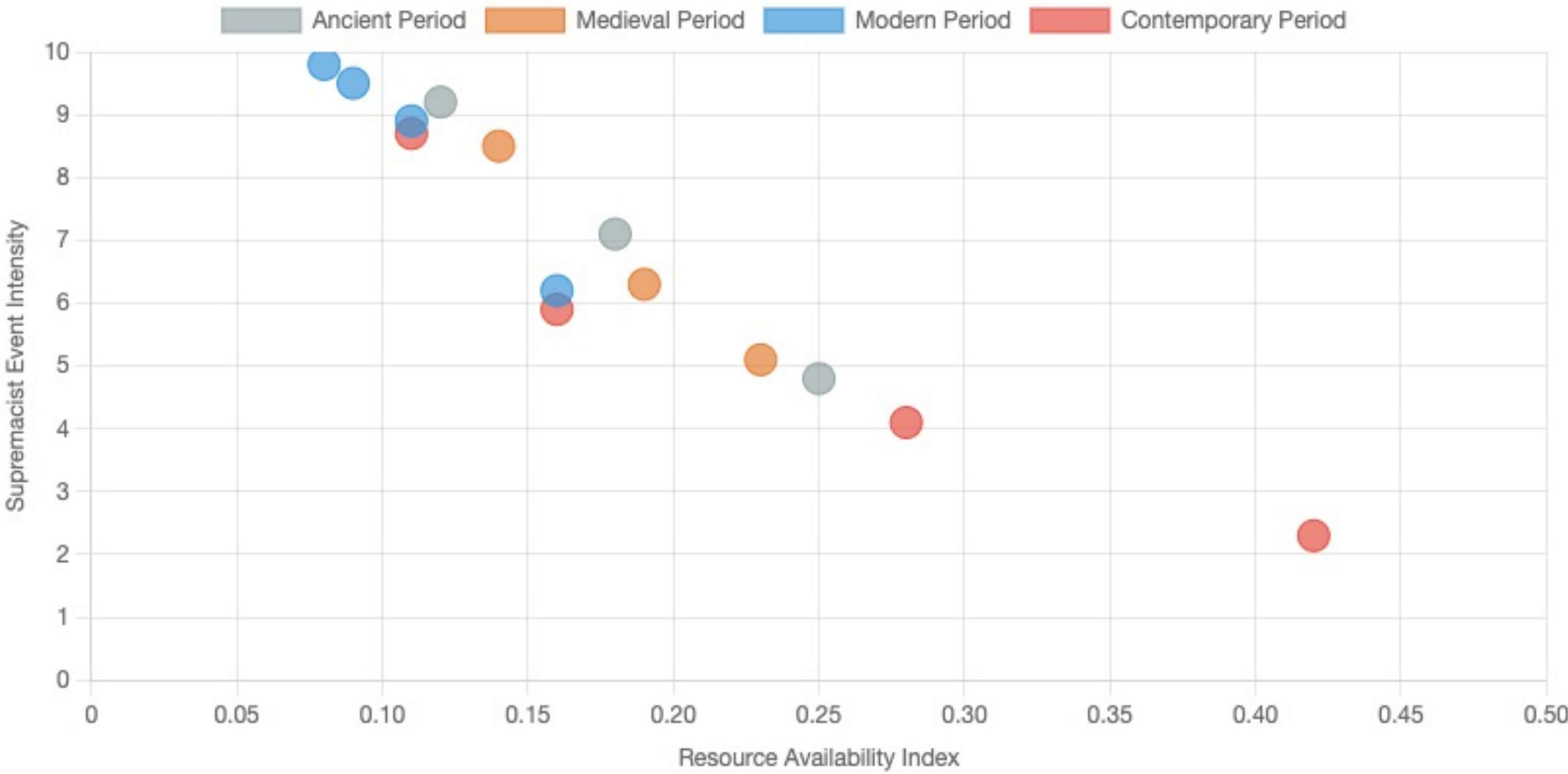

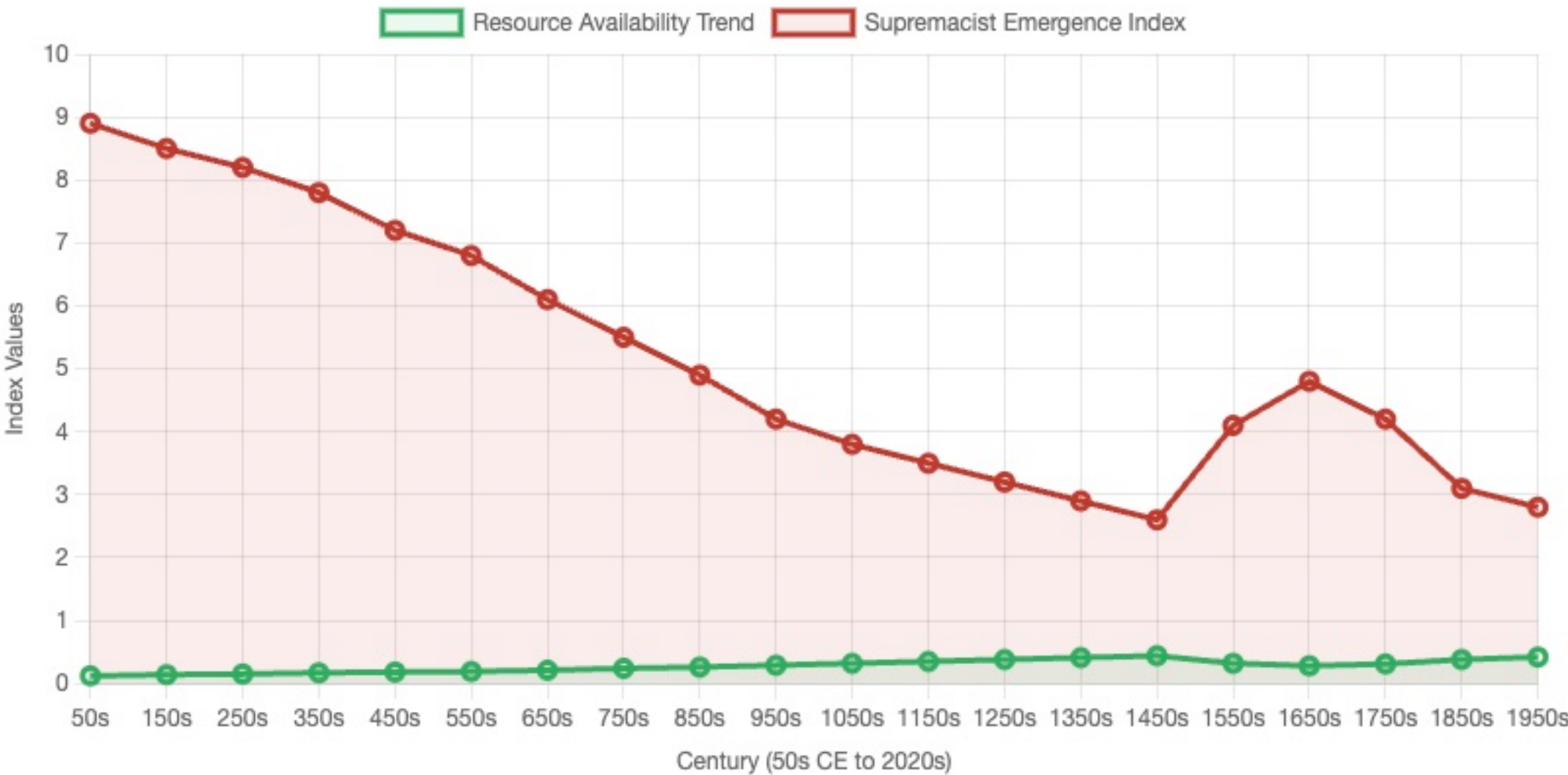
