1. **CONFLICT** — 83r.1 his FIRM vs BOTH baselines' "this" (#25 audit-closed): that will charge a ⟨J⟩udg⟨e⟩ in his Manner after the part⟨y,⟩ i⟨s⟩ executed. / — no t-stem at 3× (the hint = the h's approach stroke); diagonal bounded to ascender-space, stem zone clean; rot180 stroke-head count 1; hand-h match. Every pull (both baselines + sense) ran against the verdict — strongest class. **Not quoted in THE_TWO_LOCKS (verified §3G) — exposure is fold-in only.**
2. **CONFLICT** — 83v party tokens DIFFER ON THE LEAF (audit-sealed both ends): #1 = bare pl̄t ✓ (p-initial FIRM, no terminal-s bowl) · #2 = defts ✓. Companion's uniform "defts ×2" REFUTED on #1, confirmed on #2; Notes' "pl̄ts[?]" vindicated on the initial class, terminal-s unproven. Sense-tension logged as apparatus only.
3. **LEAN** — 82r.5 bribe token = gr⟨oa⟩t⟨e⟩s ✓eB: baselines' *groats*-limb supported (period spelling), *g[ui]fts* disfavoured (no mid-word descender ×4), survey's "crownes" retired by the guard. Supports one baseline candidate → no arbitration.
4. **OPEN** — 82v.2 ⟨and\|one⟩ Griffith DUAL retained, and-leaning ×6 sightings (= ARBITRATION #5): stroke-lean (tall d-class back-loop, same-image "and" comparators) vs sense-pull ("one Griffith"). Substance IF "and".
5. **NEW** — 81v.10 ⟨W→⟩ struck majuscule-W false start (both baselines silent); interpretation dual *[[wish-fulfilment-guarded: "anticipated William" limb attractive — skeleton only asserted]]*.
6. **LEAN** — 81r.6 ⟨pl̄t⟩ struck-lean ⚠, LOW weight (preceding case; baselines print unstruck).

8. **UPGRADE** — **fine figure FIRM 10⟨0⟩^{li} = £100** (#25 comparator gate vs 82v.1 30^{li}): baselines' "100li [£100]" corroborated; survey's "10" superseded.
9. **UPGRADE** — "Granetts[?]" → **Granetts FIRM at four layers** (82v.15); metathesis order "Gar-" not on the leaf; Garnet TRANSMISSION hypothesis (exemplar-level) untouched.
10. **UPGRADE** — **brackets closed**: "in[?on]" → in (83r.10) · "[cannot?]" → cannot ✓ (83v.4, #25) · "[Answer?][?]" → Anfwere ×2 ✓ (83v) · "sealing[?]" → fealeing FIRM (81r.1) · "[1]60[5?]" → An° 605 FIRM (elliptical century — the editorial [1] EXCLUDED) · "Lewes[?]" (81r.25) → FIRM · "Darnell[?]" → Da⟨nn\|rn⟩ell dual nn-lean (open, LOW).
11. **CONVERGENCE** — **baseline apparatus vindicated where the MS abbreviates**: Engl̄ (81v.17) = real loop-back abbreviation → their "Engl[ish]" is proper expansion · 82v bracket-tracking exact (Judḡmt compact where "Judg[men]t" bracketed; full where full) · 83v pardon-pair (#1 full / #2 p⟨ar⟩don — Companion tracked both) · & falfe clamore (83r.9) — the odd "&" is genuine.

1D — CONFLICTS, apparatus class (leaf contradicts print)

12. **CONFLICT** — **omitted-terminator class ×2**: 82r.20 tryall BARE ✓eB (baselines "tryall /") · 82v ¶6 BARE after execuc⟨o⟩n (baselines "/").
13. **CONFLICT** — **81r foot ~~William~~ STRUCK FIRM ×4** (baselines note the word, no strike) — cancelled catchword, the system's lone anomaly.
14. **CONFLICT** — **Companion-only**: 83v "/" after "Jac." and after "Oldfield" — neither is a leaf graph (the second position carries a horizontal filler-rule instead).

1E — NEW APPARATUS on the leaf (printed by neither baseline)

§2 BASELINE-INTERNAL DEFECTS (FOLD-IN CORRECTIONS, ALL USER-GATED)

- 1. CONFLICT** — **Notes §3 internal misquotes of its own §2 text ×4:** "Loyd" (leaf Lloyd FIRM) · "drowned ... in Aug. 1600" (leaf An^o 1600 FIRM ×5) · "their saying in Welch" (leaf fayings in welth) · "prosecutor" (leaf profecuter). **All four verified NOT inherited by THE_TWO_LOCKS (§3F).**
- 2. CONFLICT** — **83r diplomatic-block inconsistency:** both baselines' blocks print "the ground" while the Notes' own round-2 verification cell records "ye ground of all Justice would bee overthrowne" — leaf y^e ground FIRM resolves toward the round-2 cell (5th baseline-internal inconsistency).
- 3. CONFLICT** — **Companion 83v:** uniform "defts ×2" refuted on #1 (leaf plt); its two "/"s (post-"Jac.", post-"Oldfield") are its own separators, not leaf graphs.
- 4. VARIANT** — **presentational:** Notes' trailing "—" after "Lawe" (82v.27) — no leaf mark; baselines' "6 blocks" on 83r counted the dissolved "Finis[?]".
- Omitted-terminator CONFLICTs ×2 (§1D-12) are also baseline corrections: "tryall /" and the 82v ¶16 "/" print virgules the leaf lacks.

§3 THE_TWO_LOCKS QUOTED-READINGS AUDIT (§11.4 — WORD-FOR-WORD + LOCATOR-FOR-LOCATOR VS THE FIRM CENSUSES)

Sites audited: body ll. 500 (trial-narrative ¶), 504 (sentence ¶), 506 (suppression-failed ¶), 514 (eponym ¶), 520 (abolition ¶ echo); footnotes vr2, vr3, vr4, vr6, vr9, vr12; bibliography l. 853. Latin/print quotes (77 ER) and STAC quotes (vst-series) are outside this audit's scope (different sources).

3A — VARIANCES REQUIRING ACTION (surfaced FIRST; nothing edited)

1. **CONFLICT — BREAKING — "tooke noe order in it" (body l. 500 AND n. vr3):** the leaf reads (&) yet hee did take noe / order in it / (82r.6–7, ✓✓) and **BOTH baselines print "hee did take noe order in it"** — the quoted wording "tooke" exists in neither the leaf nor either transcription; it is article-level drift (Notes §3 checked: "tooke" appears nowhere). Sense unchanged, but as a quotation it is unsupported. **Proposed fix (2 sites): "did take noe order in it"** — the article's framing "the judge knew ... and" accommodates it directly ("...carried consideration 'in their pocketts' and 'did take noe order in it'").
 2. **OPEN — CONTEST — n. vr9 caption quote rides ARBITRATION #1:** vr9 prints the caption as "Rice ap Evan Lloyd plt / Rich: Barker Just[ice] et al defts". The leaf: Rice ap Evan Lloyd plt FIRM ✓ and Rich: Barker (Ch^r) et al defts — the office token's letterforms read **Ch^r** across 4 sightings incl. native (open C-bowl matching the hand's C, h-ascender, superscript r + point, no descender — the hand's J descends); "Just[ice]"/"Ju(—)" is not supported by the strokes; expansion candidate Ch[ivale]r (knight), with Kesselring's "Sir Richard Barker" corroborating knight-class externally. The judicial office itself is NOT in doubt (body Juftice Barker ×3). Under §11.3 a  token is not quoted as a reading — it may be described with both weights. **Proposed handling: keep the first caption line quoted (now FIRM), stop the quotation before the office token, and describe it** — e.g., quote "Rice ap Evan Lloyd plt" against "Rich: Barker ... et al defts" with a clause noting the office abbreviation reads Ch^r (knight-style, *Chivaler*) in the manuscript's letterforms where both prior transcriptions expanded "Just[ice]"; provisional pending the professional transcription; the office is independently fixed by the report body's "Juftice Barker." (Alternative, if preferred: leave "Just[ice]" with a provisional-reading flag until professional return — vr9 already carries a names-are-provisional rider, which is why this is CONTEST rather than BREAKING.)
 3. **VARIANT — APPARATUS — "sett downe in English" (body l. 500):** the leaf abbreviates — fette downe in Eng^l (81v.17, loop-back curl, native-decisive) — and both baselines properly bracket "Engl[ish]". The article prints "English" unbracketed, against its own disclosed convention (n. vst1: square brackets mark editorial expansions). **Proposed fix: "sett downe in Engl[ish]"**. *[[Same class, note-only (no fix proposed, uncertainty is bracket-internal): "deposicons" — the leaf leans de=poſic(i)ons (81v.18–19, (i) uncertain); "a large summe" — leaf fuſme (81v.20, m-macron); "examinacons" ×2 — leaf examīnac(o)ns (81v.17) / ex-aſmīacons (82r.8–9); these silent expansions match both baselines' own practice in running quotation.]]*
- #### 3B — SUPPORTED, word-for-word (campaign upgrades them to stroke-backed)
4. **CONFIRM :** "in their pocketts" (82r.6 ✓✓) · "would not permit it" (82r.11 ✓✓) · "desired to heare the examinacons of those whoe did first fynde the Murdred man and his horse" (82r.8–10 — **"whoe" correctly carries -e at this instance** [82r.9 native ✓], "Murdred" syncopated form correctly preserved) · "fyned by the Councell of the Marches for a false verdict" (81v.26–28 — **"Marches" is the correct instance-2 spelling**; the side's other instance is Marſhes) · "asked forgivenes of [the accused] for the

verdict" (82r.12–13; bracket substitution proper) · "notwithstanding was condemned and executed" (82r.14–15) · "not capable of the English Tongue" (81v.5–6; leaf leans Englifh(e)) · "written in English contrary to their sayings in welsh" (81v.7–8; leaf Englifhe — terminal-e orthographic only) · "a large summe of money was offered" (81v.20) · "confess[] his abettors" (83r.11–12 vn=till hee fhall haue confessed his abettors — the empty bracket properly discloses the suffix elision; ×3 body sites + vr4/vr12 consistent) · "[t]he bill was read in open Court w[hi]ch was to this effect" (81r.16–17 — **"w[hi]ch" properly expands the leaf's w^{ch}**; now FIRM) · "the pl[aintif]ts Brother . . . lately executed for Murder" (82v.3–4 FIRM — **the 82v instance HAS the terminal s** [The plts (B)rother], so the "pl[aintif]ts" expansion is sound; the ellipsis covers "was"; the 83v bare-plt finding does not touch this quote).

3C — ORTHOGRAPHIC class (disclosed-normalization; no action unless stricter diplomatics wanted)

5. **VARIANT** : long-f/ff normalized throughout (falfe→false, alked→asked, confelled→confess[], etc.) · case adaptations at quote openings ("A large"→"a large"; "[t]he") · "English" for Englifhe (l. 500, 2nd instance — leaf's terminal e dropped). These match the quoting convention the article discloses; consistent with both baselines.

3D — STRENGTHENING opportunities (optional, author's call)

6. **UPGRADE available — vr4 (£100)**: the fine figure is now FIRM on the leaf itself — 83r.8 (C)ancelled(·) the plt to bee fyned 10(0)^{li} + & falfe clamore (#25 comparator-gated) — so vr4's sentence, which currently rests the £100 on Kesselring alone, could add the MS pin: the second account's own "fyned 100li & false clamore" (f. 83r). *[[Also newly available if ever wanted: the "false clamor" device's earlier use in the preceding case (81r.10–11 fyned 20.^{li} ... falfe clamore) — the Notes §1 parenthetical already notices the parallel.]]*
7. **UPGRADE banked — vr9 "Lloyd"**: double-L FIRM ×4 incl. native; the caption's first line is now the strongest-verified reading in the corpus.

3E — LOCATORS (all checked)

8. **CONFIRM** : vr2 "ff. 81r–83r" (both quotes sit at f. 81v — within range) · vr3 umbrella + the **f. 81v pin for the fined juror — correct** · vr4 "f. 83r" ✓ · vr6 "f. 81r" ✓ · vr9 "f. 81r" (caption) + "f. 82v" (Brother) ✓ · bibliography "ff. 81r–83r" ✓ — consistent with the #24 boundary seal (Floyd ends 83r; 83v = Brooke v. Oldfield only, correctly excluded).

3F — INHERITANCE CHECK (Notes §3 misquotes → article)

9. **CONFIRM — CLEAN**: none of "Loyd" · "Aug. 1600" · "Welch"/"saying" · "prosecutor"(-as-quote) appears in THE_TWO_LOCKS; the drowning date is given as "in 1600" ✓.

3G — NOT-QUOTED exposures (verified absent from THE_TWO_LOCKS)

10. **CONFIRM** : the his clause (83r.1) · y^e ground / "ground of all Justice" line (83r.20–21) · the 15-sheets/60-sheets rules · the bribe token (the article wisely says "consideration" in its own voice) · (and\|one) Griffith · ~~Lewes~~ · A(p)price · ff: L(o): (C)ooke · Granetts · plt/defts (83v) · 30^{li}/Nyne/Seven-howers/averement lines. **Zero exposure for ARBITRATIONS #2–#5 and both #25 substance headlines.** (Header drafting-note mentions of "the plts Brother"/Griffith *Pedigrees* are changelog text, stripped at final build — not quotations.)

§5 THE FOLD-IN QUESTION (§8.5 — ORDER: BASELINE TRANSCRIPTIONS → COMPANION → CITING DOCUMENTS LAST; FLAGS INTACT [4D: ...]-STYLE; AUTHOR APPROVAL REQUIRED AT EACH STEP)

Decisions surfaced to the author:

- 1. THE_TWO_LOCKS fix #1 (BREAKING):** approve "tooke noe order in it" → "did take noe order in it" at body l. 500 + n. vr3?
- 2. THE_TWO_LOCKS fix #2 (CONTEST / ARBITRATION #1):** approve the vr9 caption-quote restructure (quote FIRM line, describe the office token with both weights) — or hold "Just[ice]" under its existing provisional-names rider until the professional transcription returns?
- 3. THE_TWO_LOCKS fix #3 (APPARATUS):** approve "sett downe in English" → "sett downe in Engl[ish]"?
- 4. Optional strengthenings (§3D):** add the MS £100 pin to vr4? any others wanted?
- 5. Baseline/companion fold-in:** fold the pass-4 record (this file §§1–2) into the Notes transcription + the Companion with flags intact? If yes: which Notes copy is canonical (RL Immunity Notes vs the byte-identical DDC 2_Gov Rule 12/Notes duplicate — fold both, or designate one)? *[[Note: DDC-tree edits are category-3 regardless.]]*
- 6. Citing-document audit extension:** extend §11.4 to the §4 inventory (the two Immunity Arguments pieces + the Rule 12 blueprint first)?
- 7. Infra:** the broken DDC Arguments symlink (3_→2_ re-nest) — approve re-point?
