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## SURVEY (6/6 SIDES READ FULL-LEAF, 2026-07-08)

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**Document class:** report-collection copy, ONE later-17c round hand throughout (loops, linked forms, long-f in medial positions, big swash majuscule T on paragraph openers "That/The" — a T/ff confusable pair candidate; superscript money forms 20<sup>h</sup>/30<sup>h</sup>/10<sup>h</sup>; abbreviation forms Judg<sup>m</sup>t, averem<sup>t</sup>, Attor<sup>n</sup>, Co<sup>t</sup>, Chancell<sup>r</sup>, examinacon-class, p(ar)don). NO ruling visible; paragraph-per-allegation layout with virgule / terminators — the report is a LIST of the bill's allegations, then the defense's, then Coke's propositions, then the order. Line spacing generous; ~20–26 written lines/side.

### Apparatus discovered at survey (not in either baseline as apparatus):

- **Quire-internal ink numerals, top-right of rectos:** 81r = "4" · 82r = "5" · 83r = "6" — the booklet's own leaf numbering (Harvard's f. 81 etc. is the volume foliation; per Williams 2022 the reports begin at fo. 74r). Record both systems in citations.
- **CATCHWORD SYSTEM, foot of every side read so far:** 81v "A" → 82r "A witnes" ✓ · 82r "That" → 82v "That William" ✓ · 82v "that" → 83r "that will charge" ✓ · **83r "Trinitatis" → 83v "Trinitatis 5° Jac." ✓ — meaning baselines' "Finis[?]" at 83r's foot is a DISSOLUTION CANDIDATE: the token in that position is the catchword, not a Finis (q-83r-d, TOP).** · **81r foot word "William" sits in catchword position but MISMATCHES 81v's first written word ("were well knowne...")** — either line-overflow completion of "...names were Lewes || William", or a true catchword exposing the copyist's stumble at the page turn (the ~~were~~ dittograph sits exactly there). = part of the junction crux q-81v-a (TOP).
- Catchwords double as a **completeness proof** (no leaf missing between sides) — log each in the line indexes.

### Per-side survey notes + defects:

- **81r** (2400×3541): ~24 lines + 2-line Floyd caption. Preceding-case tail (deed dispute) ends with margin "sentence"; Floyd caption + margin "Anglesey" at the bill-read line. Right edge chipped (text unaffected); moderate show-through; foxing spots. Money form "20<sup>h</sup>" superscript. Caption line 2: "Rich: Barker Ju(—) et al defts" — the office token is an abbreviation (Ju: / Just[?]) → q-81r-b.
- **81v** (2400×3537): ~26 lines. **Line 1 = THE JUNCTION CRUX (q-81v-a, TOP):** "~~were~~ well knowne to {struck token: Lewes?} «hugh ap» William examined the witnesses partially..." — survey suggests STRIKE-AND-REPLACE (yielding "well knowne to <sup>Hugh ap</sup> William" = the VICTIM) vs both baselines' parse ("well knowne to Lewes [interlined: Hugh ap] William[?]", Lewes unstruck, companion modernizing "well known to Lewes"). Sense stakes: WHO the two men were well known to (the prosecutor vs the victim). Interline geometry + strike extent = the sweep's first target. Left edge heavily chipped (verso of 81); show-through moderate. "Marshes" (commission clause) vs "Marches" (fine clause) both present ✓ baseline.
- **82r** (2400×3537): ~24 lines; catchword "That". **q-82r-a (upgraded candidate):** the bribe token reads at survey grain like "<c/g>r<o/e/u><w?>n<d/e>s" — "**crownes**" (**crowns, coin**) is a **NEW letterform-plausible candidate** beside baseline "g[ui]fts/groats"; sits "...petty Jury had (—) in their pocketts". Also "Admiralty"

with abbreviation-class medial  $\triangle$  minor; "impannelled"; the Griffith line  $\checkmark$  survey. Gutter-side clean; right edge ragged.

- **82v** (2400×3536): ~26 lines; catchword "that". "30" superscript money form; "60 sheets" clear at survey; **"Granetts" at survey grain (G-r-a-n-e-t-t-s letterform run; e/u and Gr-/Gar- questions remain for zoom)** (q-82v-a, TOP — the Garnet-hypothesis token, baseline §4.18); "Lo: Chancellor" superscript form (baselines print "Chauncellor" — form delta candidate q-82v-b); averem̄t abbreviation forms. Left edge ragged; show-through moderate-heavy.
- **83r** (2400×3536): ~22 lines; margin "order"  $\checkmark$ ; catchword "Trinitatis" (see above). **q-83r-a (TOP): the fine figure — survey reads "fyned 10"-like; baselines "100li [£100]" (and Kesselring/print £100)** — the third digit may be merged into the superscript; deployment-critical money figure → zoom mandatory. **q-83r-b:** "ye ground of all Justice would bee overthrowne" — **"ye" (thorn-form) at survey** where companion prints "the" (the Notes round-2 already saw "ye ground"); also check "overthrowne/overthrone" tail. **q-83r-c:** line-1 right end carries a long diagonal stroke/slash above "Manner" — pen-flourish vs later mark vs deletion — classify. Also: "sett him in(?) this suite" (in/on crux stands, q-83r-e); "Cancelled" c/t-medial check; "abetto<sup>s</sup>" superscript-rs forms ×2; possible underline-class stroke beneath "Readers hand" (q-83r-f — if real, an emphasis mark on the counsel-signature gate!); "Co<sup>t</sup>" superscript.
- **83v** (2400×3543): header "Trinitatis 5° Jac." with long entry-flourish + "Brooke vers Oldfield" + ~9-line paragraph ending "a p(ar)don may not bee pleaded /"; lower two-thirds BLANK with heavy show-through (mirror of 84r) — blank-verification target for the audit pass. **q-83v-a:** the pleading party token — baselines "[defts?][?]" having pleaded not guilty"; survey glyph looks p-initial ("plts?") which fights sense (the pardon-pleader should be a defendant) — letterforms-first item for the sweep (boundary case, low deployment weight).

**Standing-[?] inventory inherited from the baselines** (→ MS149-6 re-render targets, on top of the q-items above): "Granetts[?]" (=q-82v-a) · "g[ui]fts/groats[?]" (=q-82r-a) · "Hugh ap" interline role (=q-81v-a) · "Lewes[?]" 81r last line (=q-81v-a complex) · "in[?on]" 83r (=q-83r-e) · "Darnell[?]" + "sealing[?]" (preceding case, immaterial) · "An° [1]60[5?]" digit (external corroboration CLOSED via PRO List of Sheriffs; the DIGIT itself still a reading item, q-81r-c) · 83v tokens (=q-83v-a) · "Finis[?]" (=q-83r-d, dissolution candidate).

**Internal baseline inconsistency to resolve in the delta log:** the Notes §3 corroboration table prints the caption surname "Loyd" while Notes §2 + companion + round-2 verification print **"Lloyd"** — same-document inconsistency; the sweep arbitrates from the leaf (q-81r-a; survey favors "Lloyd", double-l visible).

**Copy-specific hazard profile (methodology §12.1.2):** one professional copy hand ⇒ expect FEW scribal revisions (so far: the ~~were~~ dittograph strike + the 81v line-1 event + possible 83r marks) — the hunt is for COPYIST errors: eye-skips vs the exemplar (census against sense-completeness), dropped allegation-lines (each allegation = one virgule-terminated paragraph — count them), mis-expansions, and metathesis (the Granetts/Garnetts hypothesis is exactly this class).

### ARBITRATION LIST (GROWS; = COMMISSION BRIEF SECTION)

- 1. 81r.15 caption office token — Ch<sup>r</sup> (MS letterforms, 4 sightings incl. native) vs "Just[ice]" (both baselines).** Expansion candidate Ch[ivale]r (knight); Kesselring 705 styles him "Sir Richard Barker" (corroborates knight-class); the judicial office itself is not in doubt ("Justice Barker" in the report body, 82r). Recorded, not asserted; conform-on-professional-return. Tiles: crop\_hls81rR\_b5[\_eB], native crop\_K\_81r\_caption.jpg.
- 2. 81v.1 zone B — Lewes STRUCK (MS letterforms: five sightings — nat ×3, eB tile, native crop\_C; single horizontal strike through the full word body; caret Λ + «hugh ap» interlined above) vs BOTH baselines printing "Lewes" UNSTRUCK.** Sense stakes: corrected reading "well knowne to hugh ap William(—)" (the VICTIM) vs baselines' "well knowne to Lewes ...
