TOP ITEM — q-82r-a bribe token (GEOMETRY BEFORE PARSE · ▲▲ WISH-FULFILMENT GUARD): baselines print g[ui]fts[?]/groats[?] — BOTH flagged uncertain by the baselines themselves. Survey (#19) raised "crownes" as a **NEW candidate** — it is MY candidate, so the guard runs **AGAINST** it: letterforms first, lean-only unless the skeleton excludes the alternatives; the sense-pull (coin-word = crisper bribery) is a wish-fulfilment vector. Token sits in the clause "...some of the petty Jury had <—> in their pocketts". Adjudicate IN ORDER: (1) token length + minim count; (2) initial letter class <c|g> (cf. hand-atlas closed-bowl vs open C/G rows); (3) medial <r|u|i> + <ow|oa> vowel skeleton; (4) terminal <-ts|-nes|-es>. eB regardless of nat confidence (substance-class token).
