Sole presentational difference: companion Finis[?] vs Notes Finis [?] (space before the flag). **BASELINE-INTERNAL INCONSISTENCY (feeds q-83r-b)**: the Notes' round-2 zoom-verification cell (l. 131) quotes "ye* ground of all Justice would bee overthrowne"* while BOTH diplomatic blocks print "the* ground"* — the Notes disagrees with itself; strokes decide; if y^e is on the leaf this is a form-delta vs both diplomatic blocks AND a 5th internal-inconsistency flag for #26. Legacy June native crops to reconcile THIS side: crop_Q_83r_top_severitas.jpg · crop_R_83r_order_sentence.jpg · crop_S_83r_reason_15sheets.jpg (reconcile by direct read at eB phase; crop_R covers the fine-figure zone — q-83r-a's native layer).

TOP ITEM — q-83r-a THE FINE FIGURE (GEOMETRY BEFORE PARSE · deployment-critical money): baselines print fyned 100li [£100]; Kesselring and Coke's print corroborate **£100**; the #19 survey read a 10^{li}-like figure. **COUNT DIGITS BEFORE ANY PARSE** — the third digit may be merged into the superscript ^{li} ligature. Comparators: atlas money row fyned 20.^{li} (81r.10, point before superscript) + 30^{li} (82v.1, NO point). Adjudicate IN ORDER: (1) how many digit-class graphs before the superscript; (2) zero-vs-^{li}-loop discrimination at the merge zone; (3) point-vs-no-point; (4) the [£100] gloss is the baselines' apparatus, not a claimed MS graph. **eB + legacy native crop_R regardless of nat confidence**. The wish-fulfilment guard runs BOTH ways: print/£100 pulls toward three digits; the survey's 10" pulls toward two — neither pull is evidence.

- **83r.5 re-sight (the bold 2nd token):** at full view the horizontal stroke reads as the hand's **LONG BACK-SWEEPING t-CROSSBAR habit** — "Court" ends in t whose crossbar sweeps left across the whole word at x-height; the same long-bar look recurs on .8 "Cancelled" (ll+t-bar cluster) on this very tile — same-page comparator. Downgraded to <C>ourt with <long t-crossbar|strike> dual, crossbar-LEANING; heavy ink = display weight on the order's operative noun. eB-83r-3 stays queued (substance-bearing token).
