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## STATEMENT OF EDITORIAL METHOD

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**(a)** The reader-facing edition of membrane 007, assembled from the Phase 4D-7 line index, the Lloyd deposition baseline (§007), the zoom-verdict file, and the ledger — every flag preserved, no new readings. This leaf carries the corpus's most-arbitrated single token (the answer-14 SUM, ledger B1) and four ledger name-items (A4 courier, A5 attorney, A7 autograph, plus the deponent's patronym) — all presented at finest stratum with each layer's reading cited.

**(b)** Conventions per methodology §6; <īd̄> the scribe's in-line barred said-abbreviation (systemic, confirmed on this leaf ×3). Declared aid-layer exception: the complainant's surname normalized to **Lloyd** in the Modernized layer.

**(c)** Labels 007.L1-007.L19 are the leaf's JOINED lines (left+right halves stitched at the x 0.45-0.55 seam); 007.sig = the autograph. Tiles: **b3** = crops/canon/crop\_canon\_m007\_L\_b3.jpg | ...\_R\_b3.jpg (+\_eB).

**(d)** Authorization: quoting with disclosure (2026-07-03); diplomatic only;  items — names above all — described, never quoted as readings; provisional except at letter-exact professional-verdict sites (return 2026-08-06).
