## E. STRUCTURE (TEXTUAL, FOR THE PROFESSIONAL COMMISSION)

- E1: **Answer-numbering variance** — Lloyd's answer "4" (prison/dying charge) ≠ engrossed Art. 4 (Bulkeley procurement): the administered set was likely a variant/earlier state of the engrossed instrument. Watch Phase A for any 009-side evidence.
- E2: The **selective-administration interlock** (Towneley 3,4,5,6,<sup>13</sup>,15,16 ⇌ Lloyd 1–12,14) — confirmed; note for commission.
- E3: 010 rows 1–12 = the last Opus-era readings in the file → **Phase B**  **COMPLETE 2026-07-02** (48/48 cells; verdicts below; full readings in \_WORKING\_010\_TRANSCRIPTION.md "PRECISION RE-VERIFICATION" layer). **No Opus-era-only text remains anywhere in the file.**

## VERDICTS (PHASE C ZOOM READS, 2026-07-02)

- **B6 (examination day)**: zg1date — the head-tear clips the numeral; the visible cluster ("<x?>" + "die me[nsis]") is **consistent with "xj"** (11th), **not decisive**. The 003R margin "xj[?]. Junij 1607" remains the better witness. → professional.
- **D1 (001 answer-3 struck word)**: zg1struck — reads "~~E["?]dwa["rd?]es~~" (possibly twice in the zone: after "that he" and again before the Montague clause) — **the same wrong forename ("Edward") the scribe wrote and corrected ≥4× on 002**; struck before "was of Councill as a Councillor at Lawe together w[i]th [Serjeant] Montague." The "Edwardes" anticipation error at first occurrence. → professional confirm; D1 materially advanced.

- **C-warnings (001 b7 zone):** zg1will\_b1 — "for these matters would be especialle / in the [very?] nature of a conspiracie" — the adverb "especialle" now CLEAN (the sweep's "[e]specialle[?]" flag lifts); the slot before "nature" reads bare-or-"very" (b1/b2 boundary), still bracketed.
- **C1 (001 "came from his [Countrey?/Councell?]):** zg1countrey2 — ✓ **RESOLVED** toward "his Councell": the token ends in a clear double-l ("ell"), no y-descender — "Countrey" is OUT. "Jevan ffloud told this ex[aminan]t that he came [from] his Councell, & that he had a purpose to have [a bill drawne] accordinge to those instrucion" — and the very next clause corroborates: "to retaine two other Councellors besides those w[i]th whome he had ben." Sense: Lloyd arrived at Towneley's having ALREADY consulted counsel — a third layer of professional mediation before the bill existed (the Council-in-the-Marches reading fades; the Welsh-idiom "country" reading is retired). → update the 001 section at next fold-in; professional confirm.
- **D3 (002R "the Bill was drawne [by—?] up in pap[er]):** zg2drawn — ✓ the interline reads "by this ex[aminan]t [&/or?] his [man?]" — the paper draft was drawn **by Towneley himself** (possibly "& his man," his clerk) — squarely answering Art. 4's "did not one John Towneley, Councellor at Lawe, drawe or penne the said bill." Also at zoom: "Mountague" spelling; another "E—<sup>henrie</sup>" strike-and-interline (the Edward error's 5th+ occurrence); "to be ffully satisfied." → professional confirm on the interline's tail word.
- **B4/B5 (Towneley's fee + its answer-number):** zg3fee — (i) the header reads "To . the 16 Interr[ed]" — the numeral favors **16** over 15 at zoom, which creates a SEQUENCE TENSION: the content (received of Rees ap Jevan Flo[ud] "for [C]ontinuinge[?] the <sup>s[ai]d</sup> Bill ... & no other money of any other person") answers **Art. 15's fee limb**, and the deposition's CLOSING scope-objection answer was also read "To the 16" — the two 1[5/6] headers on 003L are a **paired professional item** (one of them is misread, or the clerk mis-keyed); (ii) the verb favors "continuinge" over "contriving"; (iii) the sum line refines: "**ffower pownds & [a ffewe? / seaven?] shillings more.**" → professional (both).
- **D4 (002L examiner's marginal note):** first cut (zg2margin y 0.615–0.710) landed on BODY text — bonus recovery: "whereof the s[ai]d [Jevan] [liked?] well" (cleaner than the sweep's "[\_] the like ... well"). Recut lower (zg2margin2) → see below.
- **D4 (002L examiner's marginal note):** zg2margin2 — ✓ the note framed whole, 4 short lines: "**S[i]r R[ichard] B[?]. affirmed [the] / [in]strucions in ~~some?~~ [struck] of / the materiall points / to bee true .**" — (i) the "2[0?]" of the first-sweep guess is the secretary **B** with point ("S<sup>r</sup> R: B-"); (ii) ★ **the note itself carries a STRUCK word in the quantifier slot** ("in ~~some~~ of the materiall points" → toward "in [all?] ...," or the reverse) — the examiner REVISED how much Bulkeley affirmed; this explains the first-sweep "all points" vs re-sweep "some of the materiall points" divergence — which quantifier survived is a professional item (the direction matters: it is the court side calibrating the key admission); (iii) bonus: the adjacent body-text "~~Edwardes~~<sup>henrye</sup>" strike re-confirmed — and the struck form clearly ends "**-es**" ("Edwardes," a name-form in its own right, same as 001's struck cluster): the clerk's recurring reach for "Edwardes" before "Montague" is now a pattern (5+ occurrences) worth flagging to the commission.
- **D6 (004R Bulkeley-list gap):** zg4list — ✓ **RESOLVED: the gap slot reads "Tristram [Bulkey]"** — the answer-side list completes as S[i]r Richard (kt), Daniell, **Tristram**, W[illia]m, Launcelott — now matching the instrument's five-man cast exactly (Art. 4/5 ⇔ answer 4/5). Also in frame: "putt into this Ho: Co[urte]," "[pro]curement, advise<sup>or intreaty</sup>."
- **B2 (the Bulkeley loan amount):** zg5loan — "in Marche last past he this ex[aminan]t borro[wed] of the <sup>s[ai]d</sup> S[i]r Richard Bulkey the som of ffortie[?] [s?] , & then gave him a bill of his ha[nd] [for re]payment thereof" — March ✓, the bond ✓; the amount is a SHORT f-initial numeral + abbreviation: best



candidates "**fortie s[hillinges]**" (= £2 — a modest personal loan, which would fit the answer's innocent framing) or "fowre/fortie [pounds]". → professional (the abbreviation mark decides it).

- **D7 (004L "because he was dead" restructure):** zg4dead — the zone verified in place: "**Courte of Comon Plees at Westm[inster] / of Conspiracie, touchinge those matters. And / touchinge the wronges done to [t]his ex[aminan]ts brot[her]**" clean; the strike sits at the crop's foot edge — existence confirmed, exact struck words → professional (multispectral with D8). The re-sweep reading stands.
- **B3 (the father's sum):** zg5father + zg5father2 — "[since he] was so acquitted he hath had [& borrowed?] of his ex[aminan]ts ffather the Som [of \_\_ pow]nd & seaven Shillinges [since the] sixt day of october" — "seaven Shillinges" and the October anchor CONFIRMED clean; "hath had & borrowed[?]" (gift + loan) is a new nuance; the POUNDS figure sits under a fold/flourish — illegible at scan → professional. (First cut also re-framed the tenement lines: "Tyddyn [K]iew[?]" unchanged.)
- **B7 (the 008 order date):** zg8date — "accordinge to [an] ord[e]r made the [\_\_]tenthe[?] daie of [June]" — the ordinal's terminal reads "-tenthe," which **DISFAVORS** the sweep's "twent[ie]th" (secretary "twentieth" ends -tith); best candidates: "**the tenthe daie of June**" (10 June 1607 — giving the tidy chronology: order 10 June → examinations 11 June per the 003R margin → Trinity-term decision) or a -teenth compound (16th–19th). → professional confirm; chronologically load-bearing.
- **D9/ans-12 refinements (006R):** zg6a12\_b1/b2 — two unrecorded revisions in answer 12: the "be→was" micro-strike ("there be was [s]ome mention"); the kinsmen interline's ANCHOR refined ("then this ex[aminan]t <sup>[havinge?]</sup> divers <sup>[kinsmen?]</sup> at that tyme purposed to have [looked out good] suerties" — "in London" in the interline's unread middle or the next line). D9's final struck word (before "suerty") sits below both cuts → professional.
- **D11 (008 margin-"2" placement):** zg8m2 — ✓ **RESOLVED: the margin "2" anchors at the "And doe you beleve" line** (the brother-belief clause), NOT at the quarrels clause. Corrected boundary: **Art. 1 = the report question alone; Art. 2 = brother-belief + your-own-indictment + the Rees-quarrels** (the quarrels clause follows "yea or noe" mid-line with NO numeral — one article). Consequence: **Lloyd's answers 1–3 align with Arts. 1–3 exactly** (his answer 2 covers brother/wife/own-indictment/kinsman — as Art. 2 now reads); the E1 numbering variance SHRINKS to the answer-"4"/Art-4 tension only. Applied to \_WORKING\_008\_TRANSCRIPTION.md + companion (correction notes; full renumber deferred to post-adjudication fold-in).

"att anie tyme"? → professional. Confirmed in passing: the "to his remembraunce" interline; the pre-Barker strike (favored reading "Richard," a dittography). → D5 open-professional.
- **D2 (001 willed/refusal zone):** zg1will\_b2 — solid tokens: "...& therefore this ex[aminan]t ~~[?]~~ willed ~~[struck interline]~~ [the s[ai]d?] Jevan ffloude to be of his [Councell?], to w[i]thstande the [Cause?/suite?], [& with whome he?] might conferre ..." — TWO live parses under the strikes: (a) Towneley willed Floud [to

acquaint the Serjeant]; (b) Towneley was willed<sup>by</sup> Floud to be OF HIS COUNSEL "to withstande" — i.e., retained precisely to weather the conspiracy exposure he had just named. Direction unresolved (dark strike + struck interline); "to w[i]thstande" is NEW and solid either way. → professional (strikes); the Serjeant-name in the acquaint clause sits lower (b8 zone), not re-cut this pass.

The defense-side FEAR rationale, in the record's own word. → professional confirm (esp. "[as accessarie?/as is witnessed?]" at the g4-L5 tail).
- ★★ "Callinge in question" (b10):** the second denial reads "Neither was there anie plott practize confederacie or combynac[i]on betwene this def[endan]t and the said M[r] Bar[ker] or anie other **touchinge the callinge in question of anie of the said p[er]sons** in the said bill of compl[ain]t named for the murder ... **in or upon the said Inditem[en]ts**" — the manuscript's own term of art anticipating Coke's "drawn in question." → professional confirm (clause order).
- ★★ £20 interlineation (b10, g3/g4 seam):** "not worthe xx li in all the worlde to this def[endan]ts kn[o]wledg[e]" inserted above "s[u]re meane estate as he is" — the complainant's poverty quantified. → professional (figure: "xx li" vs "xl").
- ★★ Keys narrative REVERSED (b12):** LEWIS asked ("desiringe him that he might have the keys of the said Castell and Gaole **to his hands**, for the more [suretie?] [and] safe keepinge..."); BULKELEY refused ("that the said def[endan]t **should not have the key of the Castell**, but the Gaoler [ap]ointed by the said S[i]r Richard Bulkeley..." — read twice, g3+g4 L6). Grid's "[Sir Richard desired] that he might have the keys" RETRACTED. Also: "**S[i]r Richard Bulkeley Knight**"; "duringe his **Shir[ie]fwike**"; "forasmuche<sup>as</sup>" (caret); "(but) retorne[d] this aunswere."
- ★ Dated appointment (b4):** "aboute the moneth of **ffebruar[ie] Anno D[omi]ni 1605** this def[endan]t John Lewis was ... **nomi[n]ated and appointed** [to] be Sheriffe ... **for the yere then next followinge or duringe his Ma[jes]ties pleasure**" — fills the grid blank; chronology locks Feb 1605/6 → Aug 1606 → Oct 1606 → 1607.
- ★ Opening formula (b1–b2):** "very untrue and **scandalous**" (grid "fraudulent" retracted — "fraudulent" likely belongs to the prayer's bill-epithet, b3); "materiall matters and **things** therein conteyn[e]d"; "for sundrie **imp[er]fec[i]ons**"; contrivance "by the [instigac[i]on?] and **direcc[i]on** of the said W[illia]m Buckeley."
- ★ Row-3 structure:** prayer → saving clause ("excepc[i]on to the incertaintie[s], insufficiencie and other the imp[er]fec[i]ons [and] defects thereof ... nowe and att all tymes hereafter saved and allowed") → general traverse ("not guyltie of the said unlawfull and manifest **plotte, practizes, confederacies**,

**combinac[i]ons and misdemeano[u]rs ... nor of anie [?], [extor]c[i]on[?], sellinge of offices and other the offences ... as ... is supposed")** — grid's conflation untangled.

- ★ **The jury returns (b5, b8):** impartiality formula complete ("**w[i]thout anie p[ar]cialitie, favo[u]r, affecc[i]on, hatred or malice towards anie p[er]son or p[er]sons therein [named?]**" — and repeated globally at b9 "All wh[i]ch said [seve]rall retornes..."); "**as well Esquiers as gent[lemen]** and other good and substantiall freeholders"; "accordinge to his place and office"; "as was requisite for his Ma[jes]ties ser[vice]"; "he referreth himself[e] to the said retorne beinge of Record"; "**Graunde Jury**" (b5/b6) and "**Examined Jury**" (b8) verified as DISTINCT terms (grand = indictment; Examined = trial); trial jury "upon lief & death," "**for the body of the said Countie**"; prisoners "**warned to looke to their Challenge**"; "their lawfull challenge were then by the said **Justices** allowed (as this def[endan]t beleveth)."
